2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the enforcement of federal immigration laws and correcting inadvertent  
3 editing errors in Ordinance 121063 in connection therewith.

4 WHEREAS, on January 27, 2003, the Seattle City Council passed Ordinance 121063 concerning  
5 inquiries by Seattle City officers and employees into immigration status, and activities designed  
6 to ascertain such status; and amending Seattle Municipal Code 4.18 in connection therewith; and

7 WHEREAS, Ordinance 121063 was signed by the Mayor on February 5, 2003; and

8 WHEREAS, due to inadvertent editing errors, the amendments that Sections 2 and 3 of Ordinance  
9 121063 purported to make to Seattle Municipal Code Sections 4.18.020 and 4.18.030,  
10 respectively, were not shown in proper "strike-out and underline" fashion; and

11 WEREAS, due to a further inadvertent editing error, Section 5 of Ordinance 121063 did not specifically  
12 state that it was to be made a new section of Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 4.18; and

13 WHEREAS, The City wishes to correct these inadvertent editing errors in order to ensure the proper  
14 codification of Sections 2, 3 and 5 of Ordinance 121063.

15 NOW THEREFORE,  
16 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

17 Section 1. Seattle Municipal Code Section 4.18.020, as enacted by Ordinance 113192, is  
18 amended as follows:

**4.18.020 Mayor reports to Council.**

19 The Mayor shall report to the City Council and the people on a ~~((quarterly))~~ yearly basis ~~((-~~  
20 ~~beginning thirty (30) days from November 4, 1986,))~~ as to the actions taken and being taken in  
21 support of ~~((the ordinance codified in))~~ this chapter ~~((and Initiative 39))~~.

22 Section 2. Seattle Municipal Code Section 4.18.030, as enacted by Ordinance 113192, is  
23 amended as follows:

1 **4.18.030 City Attorney enforcement duties.**

2 Consistent with and subject to Article XIII of the City Charter and the Code of Professional  
3 Responsibility, the City Attorney is requested to defend every action brought to declare invalid  
4 any section of (~~Initiative 30 and the ordinance codified in~~) this chapter, and maintain actions  
5 enforcing provisions of (~~said Initiative 30 and~~) this chapter.

6 Section 3. Section 5 of Ordinance 121063 shall constitute a new section 4.18.040 to Seattle  
7 Municipal Code Chapter 4.18 as follows:

8 **4.18.040 Liability**

9 Nothing in this chapter is intended to create or form the basis for Liability, on the part of the  
10 City, or its officers, employees, or agents.

11 Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its  
12 approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after  
13 presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.


