ORDINANCE 121388

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AN ORDINANCE related to the Traffic Code, amending Sections 11.14.425, 11.16.120, 11.16.300, 11.16.480, 11.23.120, 11.23.380, 11.26.060, 11.26.080, 11.26.100, 11.26.220, 11.31.121, 11.72.065, 11.72.220, 11.76.015, 11.76.020, 11.76.040, 12A.08.105, 15.17.150, 15.35.010, 15.35.020, and the titles of Chapter 11.76 and Section 11.76.010 of the Seattle Municipal Code, repealing Section 11.76.050 and adding a new Section 11.76.005 to provide regulations for payment for vehicular parking at pay stations.

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the importance of parking meters as a parking management tool; and

WHEREAS, the findings of Seattle Transportation's 2002 Seattle Parking Management Study recommended the implementation of new parking pay station technology to control on-street paid parking spaces: and

WHEREAS, Seattle Transportation intends to install parking pay stations beginning in 2004; and

WHEREAS, parking pay stations provide parking management, customer service, streetscape enhancement, and revenue benefits; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 11.14.425 of the Seattle Municipal Code, as last amended by Ordinance 110956, is amended as follows:

SMC 11.14.425 Parking ((meter)) payment device.

"Parking payment device" means any device used to aid in management and control of the parking of vehicles on City streets or other rights of way, including parking meters and pay stations.

A. "Parking meter" means any mechanical or electronic device placed or erected adjacent to a parking space, which, after deposit of specified coinage and activation of the timer where required measures the period of time that occupancy of such parking space is allowed, and which indicates, electronically or mechanically, when the lawful parking period has expired.

B. "Parking pay station" means any mechanical or electronic device, except a parking meter, placed or erected on City streets and other parking areas under the jurisdiction of Seattle Transportation for the purpose of managing and controlling the use of parking spaces and requiring payment for such use



1 either by deposit of money or use of a credit or other payment card. The term includes both “pay and
2 display” types of pay stations, which dispense a proof of payment receipt to be displayed on the vehicle,
3 and “pay by space” types of pay stations, which electronically measure the lawful parking period and its
4 expiration for specific parking spaces, without issuing a receipt for display on the vehicle.

5 Section 2. Subsection C of Section 11.16.120, which section was last amended by ordinance
6 118409, is amended as follows, provided, however, that if the amendment to Subsection C of SMC
7 11.16.120 contained in Council Bill 114747 is enacted, it shall supersede the amendment contained in this
8 Section 2:

9 **SMC 11.16.120 Director of Transportation – Authority.**

10 The Director of Transportation is authorized:

11 * * * * *

12 C. To make recommendations to the City Council for parking ~~((meter))~~ rates to be
13 charged at parking payment devices ~~((within meter zones))~~ and for fees for permits issued pursuant
14 to this subtitle;

15 * * * * *

16 Section 3. Section 11.16.480 of the Seattle Municipal Code, as last amended by Ordinance
17 120794, is amended as follows:

18 **SMC 11.16.480 Director of Executive Administration to Collect Parking ~~((Meter))~~ Payment**
19 **Device Revenues.**

20 The ~~((coins))~~ payments required to be deposited in parking ~~((meters))~~ payment devices as provided
21 in this Subtitle (Chapter 11.76) are levied and assessed as fees to cover the costs of installations, inspection,
22 supervision, regulation and maintenance involved in the control of traffic and parking upon the streets and
23 the duly authorized agents of the City Director of Executive Administration shall, from time to time, collect,
24 and deposit the same in the General Fund.



1 Section 4. Subsection D of Section 11.16.300 of the Seattle Municipal Code, which section was
2 last amended by Ordinance 118409, is amended as follows:

3 **SMC 11.16.300 Traffic Engineer -- Authority -- Parking.**

4 The Traffic Engineer is authorized under the supervision of the Director of Transportation to:

5 * * * * *

6 D. Establish ~~((parking metered))~~ areas where parking is regulated by parking payment devices,
7 and the time limit for parking therein; order installation or removal of parking ~~((meters))~~payment devices
8 where it is determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the installation or
9 removal of ~~((parking meters shall be))~~ such devices is necessary to aid in the regulation, control, and
10 inspection of the parking of vehicles; and designate the parking space or spaces ~~((adjacent to each parking~~
11 meter))for which ~~((such meter))~~ a parking payment device is to be used by signs or appropriate markings
12 upon the pavement and/or the curb. Each parking payment device shall bear thereon a legend indicating the
13 days and hours when the requirement to make payment shall apply, the types and value of the payment
14 required, and the limited period of time for which parking is lawfully permitted in the parking space or
15 spaces adjacent to which the parking payment device is located ~~((Each parking meter shall be so designed,~~
16 constructed, installed and set, that upon the expiration of the time period registered by the deposit of one or
17 more coins of United States currency, it will indicate by a mechanical or electronic operation and the
18 display of an appropriate signal that the lawful parking period has expired, and during said period of time
19 and prior to the expiration thereof, will indicate the interval of time which remains of such period Each
20 parking meter shall bear thereon a legend indicating the days and hours when the requirement to deposit
21 coins therein shall apply, the value of the coins to be deposited, and the limited period of time for which
22 parking is lawfully permitted in the parking space adjacent to which the meter is located));

1 Section 5. Section 11.23.120 of the Seattle Municipal Code, as last amended by Ordinance
2 118238, is amended as follows:

3
4 **11.23.120 Fee schedules.**

5 The Director of ~~((Engineering))~~ Transportation shall recommend to the City Council, for adoption
6 by ordinance, a schedule of fees for all permits issued pursuant to the trucking and parking regulations of
7 this Part 2 of ~~((s))~~ Subtitle I of the Traffic Code. The fees shall be commensurate with the cost of
8 administration, inspection, policing and roadway maintenance involved in the use of the streets and alleys
9 within the City, and shall, wherever possible, correspond with the fees specified in RCW 46.44.094~~1~~,
10 46.44.095 and 46.44.096. Such schedule, when approved by the City Council by ordinance, shall govern
11 the amount of the fee for such permit, and the fee shall be collected by said Director as a condition to the
12 issuance or continuance of any such permit except when such permit is issued as a component of a master
13 filming permit pursuant to SMC Section 15.35.010.

14 Section 6. Section 11.23.380 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

15 **SMC 11.23.380 Disabled person's parking card.**

16 A person who has received a current and valid special disabled person's card, decal or license plate
17 from the Washington State Department of Licensing under RCW 46.16.381 shall be allowed to park a
18 vehicle being used to transport such person in parking ~~((meter))~~ spaces controlled by a City parking
19 payment device free of charge and for unlimited periods of time in parking zones or areas which are
20 otherwise restricted as to the length of time parking is permitted. This section shall have no application to
21 those zones or areas in which the stopping, parking, or standing of all vehicles is prohibited or which are
22 reserved for special types of vehicles. Such person shall not be permitted the foregoing privilege unless he
23 or she obtains and displays a distinguishing card, decal, or license plate issued pursuant to RCW 46.16.381.
24 (RCW 46.16.381)



1 Section 7. Section 11.26.060 of the Seattle Municipal Code, as last amended by Ordinance
2 112550, is amended as follows:

3
4 **SMC 11.26.060 Service parking ((meter)) hoods.**

5 A. The holder of a valid building service parking permit shall be issued a service hood, padlock
6 and keys to use in covering any parking meter, other than fifteen (15) minute meters or commercial vehicle
7 load zones, or for display in the vehicle where parking is controlled by time limit posting or parking pay
8 station rather than by parking meters. As many service hoods may be issued as the Traffic Engineer deems
9 necessary or convenient for the application upon payment of the prescribed fee.

10 B. The holder of a valid on-street service parking permit shall have a service hood installed and
11 removed from a designated parking meter, parking pay station post, or sign identifying curb areas reserved
12 for loading, bus stops, taxi stands, charter bus parking, and other such limited or no parking zones. Such
13 installation shall be done by the Traffic Engineer and in accordance with the schedule specified by the
14 permit. As many service hoods may be issued as the Traffic Engineer deems necessary or convenient for
15 the application upon payment of the prescribed fee.

16 Section 8. Section 11.26.080 of the Seattle Municipal Code, as last amended by Ordinance
17 112550, is amended as follows:

18 **SMC 11.26.080 Service parking in ((metered)) pay parking area.**

19 A. Upon entering any available metered parking space, the building service parking permittee
20 shall place the service hood over the meter and lock same in a neat and tidy manner as prescribed for the
21 particular hood being used and shall place the service parking permit on the dashboard ~~((of the vehicle))~~ so
22 that it is clearly visible through the front window of the vehicle ~~((; provided, that service hoods shall not be~~
23 ~~placed and locked over fifteen (15) minute meters))~~.

24



1 B. Upon entering any available parking space controlled by a parking pay station, the building
2 service permittee shall display the building service parking permit in accordance with the directions
3 thereon. The service hood shall be placed on the dashboard on the driver's side with the window of the
4 service hood displaying the ownership and service address so that it is clearly visible through the window of
5 the vehicle.

6 C. Use of building service hoods in fifteen (15) minute parking zones and commercial vehicle
7 load zones is prohibited.

8 Section 9. Section 11.26.100 of the Seattle Municipal Code, as last amended by Ordinance
9 112550, is amended as follows:

10 **SMC 11.26.100 Service parking in ((nonmetered)) area without parking payment devices.**

11 Upon entering any parking space in an an ((nonmetered)) area where parking is not controlled by
12 parking payment devices, the building service parking permittee shall display the building service parking
13 permit in accordance with the directions thereon. The service hood shall be left on the dashboard on the
14 driver's ((seat)) side-with the window of the service hood displaying the ownership and service address
15 clearly visible through the window of the vehicle.

16 Section 10. Section 11.26.220 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

17 **SMC 11.26.220 Service parking --- Passenger vehicle.**

18 No passenger-type vehicle shall be parked on the authority of ((the)) a service permit, or at a meter,
19 parking pay station post or sign covered by a service hood; provided, that ((station-wagons)) truck-licensed
20 vehicles designed to provide seating for no more than three passengers and displaying the firm name in
21 letters not less than two (2) inches high and bearing truck license plates may be accorded this privilege.

22 Section 11. Section 11.31.121 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

23 **11.31.121 Monetary penalties – Parking infractions.**

1 The base monetary penalty for violation of each of the numbered provisions of the Seattle
 2 Municipal Code listed in the following table shall be as shown, unless and until the penalty shown below
 3 for a particular parking infraction is modified by Local Rule of the Seattle Municipal Court adopted
 4 pursuant to the Infraction Rules for Courts of Limited Jurisdiction ("IRLJ") or successor rules to the
 5 IRLJ:

Section 12. Subsection B of Section 11.72.065, which section was last amended by Ordinance 119011, is amended as follows:

11.72.065 Disabled parking --- Violation.



1
2 B. Any person who meets the criteria for special parking privileges under RCW 46.16 shall
3 be allowed free of charge to park a vehicle being used to transport that person for unlimited periods of
4 time in parking zones or areas (including zones or areas with parking ~~((meters))~~ payment devices) which
5 are otherwise restricted as to the length of time parking is permitted. This section does not apply to those
6 zones or areas in which the stopping, parking, or standing of all vehicles is prohibited or which are
7 reserved for special types of vehicles. The person shall obtain and display a disabled parking placard or
8 license plate under RCW Chapter 46.16 to be eligible for the privileges under this section.

9 *****

10 Section 13. Section 11.72.220 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

11 **11.72.220 Meter -- Hooded.**

12 No person shall, stop, stand or park a vehicle where parking meters, posts or signs are hooded,
13 except as otherwise provided in this subtitle.

14 Section 14. The title of Chapter 11.76 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

15 **Chapter 11.76**
16 **PARKING ~~((METER))~~ PAYMENT DEVICE OPERATIONS**

17 *****

18 Section 15. A new Section 11.76.005 is added to the Seattle Municipal Code as follows:

19 **SMC 11.76.005 Display of proof of payment receipt.**

20 It is unlawful to park or permit to be parked any vehicle in a space controlled by a "pay and
21 display" parking pay station without properly displaying proof of payment. For parallel parking on one-
22 and two-way streets, proper display of proof of payment requires affixing the receipt dispensed by the
23 parking pay station to the interior of the front curbside window of the vehicle in such a manner that the
24 expiration time and date are readily visible from the exterior. For front- and rear-end angle parking,



1 proper display of proof of payment means affixing the receipt to the interior of the front window on the
2 driver's side of the vehicle in such a manner that the expiration time and date are readily visible from the
3 exterior. For motorcycles, receipts shall be affixed on the headlight cover.

4 Section 16. The title of Section 11.76.010 of the Seattle Municipal code is amended as follows:

5 **11.76.010 Parking meters – Deposit of coins and time limit.**

6 * * * * *

7 Section 17. Section 11.76.015 of the Seattle Municipal Code, which section was last amended
8 by Ordinance 112261, is amended as follows:

9 **SMC 11.76.015 Parking ((prohibited when meter indicates)) violations at parking payment**
10 **devices.**

11 A. No person shall stop, stand, or park, or permit a vehicle within his control to be parked in
12 any parking meter space while the parking meter for such space displays the words "Violation," ((or))
13 "Expired," or the international symbol for "No Parking" (®), or otherwise indicates that the meter is out
14 of order; provided that this section does not apply to a vehicle properly displaying an unexpired valid
15 proof of payment receipt issued by a parking pay station.

16 B. No person shall stop, stand or permit a vehicle within his control to be parked in any parking
17 space controlled by a "pay and display" parking pay station without displaying on the vehicle an unexpired
18 and valid proof of payment receipt issued by a parking pay station in the manner described in the directions
19 on the receipt.

20 C. No person shall stop, stand or permit a vehicle within his control to be parked in any parking
21 space controlled by a "pay by space" parking pay station beyond the amount of time purchased for that
22 space.



1 D. This section shall not apply to the act of parking or to the necessary time ~~((which is))~~
2 required to activate the timer on the parking meter or to obtain a parking pay station receipt, or to the
3 parking of certified carpool vehicles in accordance with the provisions of Section 11.23.410.

4 Section 18. Section 11.76.020 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

6 **SMC 11.76.020 Parking longer than time limit.**

7 It is unlawful for any person to park a vehicle in any ~~((such parking meter))~~ parking space for a
8 consecutive period of time longer than that limited period of time for which parking is lawfully permitted in
9 the parking ~~((meter))~~ space as indicated in the legend on the parking meter or pay station, irrespective of the
10 ~~((number or amounts of the coins deposited in such meter))~~ amount paid; provided, that this section shall
11 not apply to the parking of certified carpool vehicles in accordance with the provisions of Section
12 11.23.410.

13 Section 19. Section 11.76.040 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

14 **SMC 11.76.040 Illegal use.**

22 filming permit, the Director of Transportation, or as to park drives and boulevards, the Superintendent of
23 Parks and Recreation, may close public places for a duration consistent with preserving necessary access
24 to adjacent properties; authorize temporary changes in the appearance thereof; relocate street signs and



1 other fixtures; permit erection of temporary structures and parking of vehicles in designated areas longer
2 than twenty-four (24) hours or time limits set by parking payment devices (~~meter limits~~); and provide
3 other appropriate services.

4 Applications for a master filming permit shall be made to the Director of the Office of Economic

9 and Chapters 15.08 through 15.46, inclusive. Each permit component shall be subject to all of the terms
10 and conditions contained in the authorizing section of the Seattle Municipal Code except the individual
11 permit fee.



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Section 24. Section 15.35.020 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

15.35.020 Terms and conditions.

A filming permit may be conditioned upon restoration of the public place and reimbursement of City expenses for the filming, including, among other expenditures, coordination with abutting owners, site consultations with traffic engineers, traffic control, site presence, removal and reinstallation of street fixtures; providing barricades, meter-hooding, and like activities as required; and upon compensation for lost parking ((meter)) revenues at the site.

Section 25. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

Dear Council President Steinbrueck:

In September, I submitted an ordinance to Council that revised several sections of the Municipal Code to support the implementation of on-street parking pay stations to replace single space parking meters. The Transportation Committee suggested that technical changes regarding pay stations be made to additional sections of the Municipal Code. This resulted in a change of title from the original ordinance and, therefore, the need to submit this substitute legislation for introduction to Full Council.

The 2002 Parking Management Study conducted by Seattle Transportation (SDOT) recommended implementing new parking pay station technology to replace single-space meters for the control of on-street paid parking. Parking pay stations provide benefits to parking management, customer service, streetscape enhancement, and parking revenue. The installation of the pay stations is scheduled to begin in early 2004. Changes to the Seattle Municipal Code are necessary to allow the use of this new pay station technology, in addition to the existing single-space meters.

This ordinance defines a parking payment device to include pay stations as well as meters; describes the Traffic Engineer's authority with respect to parking payment devices; describes the use of service parking meter hoods at parking pay stations; describes the process for service parking in areas without parking payment devices; expands the restrictions for passenger vehicle service parking to include parking pay station posts or signs; and defines payment device operations with respect to displaying proof of payment receipt, depositing coins, parking violations at parking payment devices, parking longer than the time limit, illegal use, and tampering with parking payment devices.

11.72.065 Disabled parking --- Violation.

B. Any person who meets the criteria for special parking privileges under RCW 46.16 shall be allowed free of charge to park a vehicle being used to transport that person for unlimited periods of



1 time in parking zones or areas (including zones or areas with parking ~~((meters))~~ payment devices) which
2 are otherwise restricted as to the length of time parking is permitted. This section does not apply to those
3 zones or areas in which the stopping, parking, or standing of all vehicles is prohibited or which are

15 Section 15. A new Section 11.76.005 is added to the Seattle Municipal Code as follows:

16 **SMC 11.76.005 Display of proof of payment receipt.**

17 It is unlawful to park or permit to be parked any vehicle in a space controlled by a “pay and
18 display” parking pay station without properly displaying proof of payment. For parallel parking on one-
19 and two-way streets, proper display of proof of payment requires affixing the receipt dispensed by the
20 parking pay station to the interior of the front curbside window of the vehicle in such a manner that the
21 expiration time and date are readily visible from the exterior. For front- and rear-end angle parking,
22 proper display of proof of payment means affixing the receipt to the interior of the front window on the
23 driver’s side of the vehicle in such a manner that the expiration time and date are readily visible from the
24 exterior. For motorcycles, receipts shall be affixed on the headlight cover.



1 Section 16. The title of Section 11.76.010 of the Seattle Municipal code is amended as follows:

2 **11.76.010 Parking meters – Deposit of coins and time limit.**

3 * * * * *

4 Section 17. Section 11.76.015 of the Seattle Municipal Code, which section was last amended
5 by Ordinance 112261, is amended as follows:

6 **SMC 11.76.015 Parking ((prohibited when meter indicates)) violations at parking payment**
7 **devices.**

8 A. No person shall stop, stand, or park, or permit a vehicle within his control to be parked in
9 any parking meter space while the parking meter for such space displays the words "Violation," ((or))
10 "Expired," or the international symbol for "No Parking" (ⓧ), or otherwise indicates that the meter is out
11 of order; provided that this section does not apply to a vehicle properly displaying an unexpired valid
12 proof of payment receipt issued by a parking pay station.

13 B. No person shall stop, stand or permit a vehicle within his control to be parked in any parking
14 space controlled by a "pay and display" parking pay station without displaying on the vehicle an unexpired
15 and valid proof of payment receipt issued by a parking pay station in the manner described in the directions
16 on the receipt.

17 C. No person shall stop, stand or permit a vehicle within his control to be parked in any parking
18 space controlled by a "pay by space" parking pay station beyond the amount of time purchased for that
19 space.

20 D. This section shall not apply to the act of parking or to the necessary time ((which is))
21 required to activate the timer on the parking meter or to obtain a parking pay station receipt, or to the
22 parking of certified carpool vehicles in accordance with the provisions of Section 11.23.410.

23 Section 18. Section 11.76.020 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

1 **SMC 11.76.020 Parking longer than time limit.**

2 It is unlawful for any person to park a vehicle in any ~~((such parking meter))~~ parking space for a
3 consecutive period of time longer than that limited period of time for which parking is lawfully permitted in
4 the parking ~~((meter))~~ space as indicated in the legend on the parking meter or pay station, irrespective of the
5 ~~((number or amounts of the coins deposited in such meter))~~ amount paid; provided, that this section shall
6 not apply to the parking of certified carpool vehicles in accordance with the provisions of Section
7 11.23.410.

8 Section 19. Section 11.76.040 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

9 **SMC 11.76.040 Illegal use.**

10 No person shall **tamper with or open any parking payment device**, deposit or cause to be
11 deposited in any parking ~~((meter))~~ payment device any slug, button or any other device or substance as
12 substitutes for ~~((coins))~~ legal tender of the United States, **or counterfeit or alter any parking pay station**
13 **receipt.**~~((UVC 22-5))~~

14 Section 20. Section 11.76.050 of the Seattle Municipal Code is hereby repealed.

15 Section 21. Section 12A.08.105 of the Seattle Municipal Code, as last amended by Ordinance
16 120794, is amended as follows:

17 **12A.08.105 Unauthorized manufacture, duplication, use or possession of a key which opens a**
18 **parking ~~((meter))~~ payment device.**

19 It is unlawful for any person to knowingly manufacture, duplicate, use or possess a key which
20 opens a parking ~~((meter))~~ payment device located within the limits of the City, unless authorized to do
21 so by the Director of ~~((Engineering))~~ Transportation or the City Director of Executive Administration.

22 Section 22. Subsection A of Section 15.17.150 of the Seattle Municipal Code, which section was
23 last amended by Ordinance 118409, is amended as follows:
24



1 **15.17.150 Sidewalk displays.**

2 The Director of Transportation may issue a permit to the owner or manager of a business upon
3 adjoining property making sales at retail to the public in a zone other than single-family or lowrise multi-
4 family zone to display on a public sidewalk goods or wares that are being offered for sale inside the
5 business. Sidewalk displays are subject to rules of the Director of Transportation, the terms and conditions
6 of the permit, and the following criteria:

7 A. The display may not obstruct passage on the sidewalk nor the use of any crosswalk,
8 wheelchair ramp, bus or taxi loading zone. The display must allow at least six feet (6') of clearance for
9 pedestrian passage to the nearest street trees; utility pole; traffic control signs, parking ~~((meters))~~
10 payment devices, or fire hydrants and may not be fastened to any of the foregoing;

11 * * * * *

12 Section 23. Section 15.35.010 of the Seattle Municipal Code, as last amended by Ordinance
13 118409, is amended as follows:

14 **15.35.010 Permits for filming.**

15 To accommodate filming motion pictures and videotaping productions, and pursuant to a master
16 filming permit, the Director of Transportation, or as to park drives and boulevards, the Superintendent of
17 Parks and Recreation, may close public places for a duration consistent with preserving necessary access
18 to adjacent properties; authorize temporary changes in the appearance thereof; relocate street signs and
19 other fixtures; permit erection of temporary structures and parking of vehicles in designated areas longer
20 than twenty-four (24) hours or time limits set by parking payment devices ~~((meter limits))~~; and provide
21 other appropriate services.

22 Applications for a master filming permit shall be made to the Director of the Office of Economic
23 Development who shall coordinate component applications with each appropriate permitting authority.
24 After each component permit is approved by the applicable permitting authority, the permit shall be



1 issued in the nature of a master filming permit for the activities described, covering uses contemplated
2 by Seattle Municipal Code Sections 11.23.120, 15.04.074, 21.04.530, 22-.602.040 C and 22.901Q.010
3 and Chapters 15.08 through 15.46, inclusive. Each permit component shall be subject to all of the terms
4 and conditions contained in the authorizing section of the Seattle Municipal Code except the individual
5 permit fee.

6 Section 24. Section 15.35.020 of the Seattle Municipal Code is amended as follows:

7 **15.35.020 Terms and conditions.**

8 A filming permit may be conditioned upon restoration of the public place and reimbursement of
9 City expenses for the filming, including, among other expenditures, coordination with abutting owners,
10 site consultations with traffic engineers, traffic control, site presence, removal and reinstallation of street
11 fixtures; providing barricades, meter-hooding, and like activities as required; and upon compensation for
12 lost parking ((meter)) revenues at the site.

13 Section 25. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its
14 approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after
15 presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.



ORDINANCE 121388

AN ORDINANCE related to the Traffic Code, amending Sections 11.14.425, 11.16.120, 11.16.300, 11.16.480, 11.23.120, 11.23.360, 11.26.050, 11.26.080, 11.26.100, 11.26.220, 11.31.121, 11.72.065, 11.72.320, 11.76.015, 11.76.020, 11.76.040, 12A.09.105, 15.17.150, 15.35.010, 15.35.020, and the titles of Chapter 11.76 and Section 11.76.010 of the Seattle Municipal Code, repealing Section 11.76.050 and adding a new Section 11.76.005 to provide regulations for payment for vehicular parking at pay stations.

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the importance of parking meters as a parking management tool; and

WHEREAS, the findings of Seattle Transportation's 2002 Seattle Parking Management Study recommended the implementation of new parking pay station technology to control on-street paid parking spaces; and

WHEREAS, Seattle Transportation intends to install parking pay stations beginning in 2004; and

WHEREAS, parking pay stations provide parking management, customer service, streetscape enhancement, and revenue benefits; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1, Section 11.14.425 of the Seattle Municipal Code, as last amended by Ordinance 110966, is amended as follows:

SMC 11.14.425 Parking ((meter)) payment device.

"Parking payment device" means any device used to aid in management and control of the parking of vehicles on City streets or other rights of way, including parking meters and pay stations.

A. "Parking meter" means any mechanical or electronic device placed or erected adjacent to a parking space, which, after deposit of specified coinage and activation of the timer where required measures the period of time that occupancy of such parking space is allowed, and which indicates, electronically or mechanically, when the lawful parking period has expired.

B. "Parking pay station" means any mechanical or electronic device, except a parking meter, placed or erected on City streets and other parking areas under the jurisdiction of Seattle Transportation for the purpose of managing and controlling the use of parking spaces and requiring payment for such use either by deposit of money or use of a credit or other payment card. The term includes both "pay and display" types of pay stations, which dispense a proof of payment receipt to be displayed on the vehicle.
