BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of Eighteen Million, Nine Hundred Seventy Nine Thousand, Four Hundred Sixty Seven and 35/100 dollars (\$18,979,467.35) on Summit mechanical warrants numbered, 4000884689- 400086827, plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of Fifty Five Million, Five Hundred Forty Seven Thousand, Four Hundred Eighty Seven and 47/100 dollars, (55,547,487.47) are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter 42.23RCW.

SECTION 2. Payment of the sum of Twenty Four Million, Eight Hundred Forty Thousand, Six Hundred Thirty and 05/100 dollars (\$24,840,630.05) on City General Salary Fund mechanical warrants numbered 50863159 - 50865034 plus manual warrants, agencies warrants, and direct deposits numbered 500001 – 509659 representing Gross Payrolls for payroll ending date Nov. 30, 2004 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on Dec. 8, 2004 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current expenses shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.
