ORDINANCE 172865

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the Payments thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of Eleven Million, Nine Hundred Twenty One Thousand, Four Hundred Twenty Four and 46/100 dollars (\$11,921,424.46) on Summit mechanical warrants numbered, 4001462291 - 4001464775, plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of Twenty Million, Two Hundred Seventy Five Thousand, Six Hundred Four and 76/100 dollars, (\$20,275,604.76) are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter 42.23RCW.

SECTION 2. Payment of the sum of Thirty One Million, Six Hundred Eighty Three Thousand, Two Hundred Four and 64/100 dollars (\$31,683,204.64) on City General Salary Fund mechanical warrants numbered 51047151 - 51048719 plus manual warrants, agencies warrants, and direct deposits numbered 470001 - 480943 representing Gross Payrolls for payroll ending date Nov. 11, 2008 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on Nov. 20, 2008 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current expenses shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.



AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle Department of Transportation; establishing the fee schedule related to overlegal truck permits and parking pursuant to the trucking and parking regulations of the Traffic Code; and superseding previous overlegal truck permit and parking fee schedules.

ORDINANCE NO. 122851

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle Department of Transportation; adopting a schedule of fees for the refilling and restoration of utility cuts and other openings in city streets, alleys, and other public places for construction or other activities; and authorizing the Director of Transportation to collect such fees in accordance with Seattle Municipal Code Chapter 15.26.

ORDINANCE NO. 122843

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Seattle Public Utilities to execute an amendment to an agreement with Waste Management of Washington for transportation and disposal of waste.
