**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1. The restriction imposed by the following budget proviso, pertaining to \$750,000 appropriated in 2010, is lifted and is no longer a restriction for any purpose including for Subsection 1(b) of Ordinance 123177:

Planning and Development	# 108-2-A-1	“Of the appropriation in the 2010 budget for the Department of Planning and Development's Planning BCL, \$750,000 is appropriated solely to develop and implement shared Council and Mayoral land use planning priorities, identified by the Council through ordinance or resolution after adoption of the 2010 Budget, and may be spent for no other purpose.”	U2900


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten (10) days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.

**Legislation Title:**

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 2010 budget of the Department of Planning and Development; lifting a proviso on \$750,000 in the Planning Budget Control Level in the 2010 adopted budget.

• **Summary of the Legislation:**

This legislation lifts a proviso on \$750,000 appropriated in the Department of Planning and Development's (DPD) Planning Budget Control Level.

• **Background:**

In the 2010 budget, adopted by Ordinance 123177, Council imposed a proviso on \$750,000 appropriated in DPD's planning BCL. This proviso limited spending as follows:

Of the appropriation in the 2010 budget for the Department of Planning and Development's Planning BCL, \$750,000 is appropriated solely to develop and implement shared Council and Mayoral land use planning priorities, identified by the Council through ordinance or resolution after adoption of the 2010 Budget, and may be spent for no other purpose.

The proviso was intended to encourage the Mayor and the DPD to complete the work set out in associated Statement of Legislative Intent (SLI) 108-1-A-2. SLI 108-1-A-2 requests that Mayor and the Department of Planning and Development work with the Council and Planning Commission to prioritize a work program for 2010 and a tentative work program for 2011 that reflects shared priorities.




