BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of \$21,350,828.76 on Summit mechanical warrants numbered 4001859859 – 4001862425 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E- Payables of \$270,327.56 on Summit 9000002822 - 9000002918 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of \$36,889,992.56 are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter 42.23RCW.


SECTION 2. Payment of the sum of \$33,164,957.16 on City General Salary Fund mechanical warrants numbered 51133247- 51134214 plus manual warrants, agencies warrants, and direct deposits numbered 180001 – 188460 representing Gross Payrolls for payroll ending date April 26, 2011 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council on May 5, 2011 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

SECTION 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current expenses shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.



AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Parks and Recreation; accepting deeds for real property and property rights acquired in connection with the Neighborhood Parks, Green Spaces, Trails, and Zoo Levy in designated greenspaces (Southwest Queen Anne Greenbelt, Northeast Queen Anne Greenbelt, Westlake Greenbelt, St. Mark's Greenbelt, Harrison Ridge Greenbelt, Duwamish Head Green Space, West Duwamish Greenbelt, East Duwamish Greenbelt, Seola Beach Greenbelt, Thornton Creek Natural Area, Leschi Natural Area, Me-Kwa-Mooks Natural Area, Longfellow Creek Green Space, Kubota Gardens Natural Area, Kiwanis Ravine Green Space, Puget Creek Green Space, and Puget Ridge Green Space), for park additions (Ballard Corners Park, Hing Hay Park and the Whittier
