AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the payment thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of \$14,399,395.12 on Summit mechanical warrants numbered 4001868318 - 4001871293 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E – Payables of \$201,872.46 on Summit 9000003073 – 9000003165 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) of \$8,686,867.81 are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter 42.23 RCW.

SECTION 2. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current expenses shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.





AN ORDINANCE, relating to a utility tunnel under the alley between 3rd Avenue and 4th Avenue, north of Spring Street, amending Ordinance 96413, as amended by Ordinances 119126 and 121855, transferring the permission from U.S. West Communications, Inc. to Qwest Corporation, updating the insurance and bond requirements, and amending the annual fee; renewing the term of the permit; providing for acceptance of the permit and conditions; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.
