AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the payment thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of \$16,890,104.53 on Summit mechanical warrants numbered 4001892378 – 4001895378 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E-Payable \$195,615.89 on Summit 9000003687– 9000003768 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of \$18,681,023.41 are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter 42.23RCW.

SECTION 2. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current expenses shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.

ORDINANCE NO. 123663

AN ORDINANCE authorizing, in 2011, acceptance of funding from non-City sources; authorizing the heads of the Seattle Fire Department, Seattle Police Department, Department of Planning and Development, Department of Neighborhoods, Department of Finance and Administrative Services, Human Services Department, the Office of Economic Development, Seattle Department of Transportation, and Seattle Public Utilities to accept specified grants and private funding and to execute, deliver, and perform corresponding agreements; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.

ORDINANCE NO. 123664

AN ORDINANCE related to the 2011 Budget; amending Ordinance 123442, which adopted the 2011 Budget, including the 2011-2016 Capital Improvement Program (CIP); changing appropriations to various departments and budget control levels, and from various funds in the Budget; making cash transfers between various City funds; adding new projects; revising project allocations for certain projects in the 2011-2016 CIP; creating new positions, revising project descriptions; revising budget control level (BCL) purpose statements; amending Ordinance 123637; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts; all by a 3/4 vote of the City Council.
