2 AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering  
3 the payment thereof.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

6 SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of \$18,359,678.55 on Summit mechanical warrants  
7 numbered 4001895379– 4001898647 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E- Payables of  
8 \$146,964.38 on Summit 9000003769 – 9000003833 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in  
9 the amount of \$14,878,198.06 are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter  
10 42.23RCW.

11 SECTION 2. Payment of the sum of \$34,024,105.04 on City General Salary Fund  
12 mechanical warrants numbered 51139301– 51140680 plus manual warrants, agencies warrants, and  
13 direct deposits numbered 300001 – 307979 representing Gross Payrolls for payroll ending date July  
14 19, 2011 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which were audited by  
15 the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council July 28, 2011 consistent  
16 with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby  
17 approved.


18 SECTION 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this  
19 ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

20 Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the  
21 Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take  
22 effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.



### ORDINANCE NO. 123667

AN ORDINANCE relating to indigent public defense services; authorizing the City Budget Director to execute a contract for secondary defender services; authorizing a structure with only two public defense service providers for an interim period until a third provider contract is executed; ratifying and confirming prior acts; and declaring an emergency to provide for restoration of a program of essential indigent public defense services delayed by litigation.

### ORDINANCE NO. 123668

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health; amending various sections of Chapters 3.30, 3.60, 5.78, 6.430, 9.25, 10.01, 10.03, 10.10, 10.13, 10.18, 10.24, 10.25, 10.26, 10.54, 10.56, 10.72, 10.76, 21.08, 21.12, 21.16, 21.36, 21.43, 22.801, 22.900G, 23.50, 23.60, 23.57, 23.69, 25.06, and 25.10 of the Seattle Municipal Code ("SMC") to change its name to "Public Health - Seattle and King County"; adopting and authorizing execution of a new interlocal agreement between the City of Seattle and King County entitled '2011 King County/City of Seattle Interlocal Agreement Regarding Public Health - Seattle & King County', and repealing Ordinance 118377, the prior interlocal agreement between the City of Seattle and King County entitled 'SKCDPH Health Interlocal Agreement'; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.

### ORDINANCE NO. 123669

AN ORDINANCE accepting for general street purposes 15 deeds conveyed to the City of Seattle by the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority ("Sound Transit") in connection with the Central Link Light Rail Transit Project as agreed to in a Property Acquisition and Transfer Procedures Agreement between the City of Seattle and Sound Transit, dated August 12, 2003 ("Property Transfer Agreement"); laying off, opening, widening, extending, and establishing portions of the rights-of-way located on Martin Luther King Jr. Way South between South Morgan Street and South Warsaw Street, and South Findlay Street and South Graham Street; accepting a deed conveying to the City the rights of Sound Transit under a certain Slope and Soil Nail Easement; placing the real property conveyed by the 16 deeds under the jurisdiction of the Seattle Department of Transportation; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.

### ORDINANCE NO. 123670

AN ORDINANCE accepting for general street purposes 16 deeds conveyed to the City of Seattle by the Central Puget Sound Regional Transit Authority ("Sound Transit") in connection with the Central Link Light Rail Transit Project as agreed to in a Property Acquisition and Transfer Procedures Agreement between the City of Seattle and Sound Transit, dated August 12, 2003 ("Property Transfer Agreement"); laying off, opening, widening, extending, and establishing portions of the rights-of-way located on Martin Luther King Jr. Way South between South Orcas Street and South Raymond Street, South Eddy Street and South Angel Place, South Dawson Street and South Brandon Street, and South Lucile Street and South Findlay Street; placing the real property conveyed by the 16 deeds under the jurisdiction of the Seattle Department of Transportation; and ratifying and confirming certain prior acts.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Neighborhoods; authorizing implementation of certain Neighborhood Matching Fund projects in 2011, and specifying that 2011 appropriations for the Neighborhood Matching Subfund shall carry forward automatically to future budget years.
