5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

6 SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of \$17,934,747.93 on Summit mechanical warrants numbered  
7 4001898648 – 4001902509 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E-Payable \$218,826.20 on Summit  
8 9000003834 – 9000003918 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of \$26,302,950.45 are  
9 presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter 42.23RCW.

10 SECTION 2. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is  
11 hereby ratified and confirmed.

12 SECTION 3. This ordinance, being an ordinance required for the payment of salaries or current  
13 expenses shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it  
14 shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.




