ORDINANCE 123728

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering
the payment thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Payment of the sum of \$15,861,636.92 on Summit mechanical warrants numbered
4001923187 – 4001926163 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E-Payables of \$131,952.70 on
Summit 9000004443 – 9000004524 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of
\$13,453,463.43 are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter 42.23RCW.


SECTION 2. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is


