COUNCIL BILL 117741

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money to pay certain audited claims and ordering the payment thereof.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Payment of the sum of \$13,939,254.91 on Summit mechanical warrants numbered 4002151311 – 4002154727 plus manual or cancellation issues for claims, E-Payables of \$181,344.05 on Summit 9000010754 – 9000010851 and Electronic Financial Transactions (EFT) in the amount of \$28,622,553.51 are presented for ratification by the City Council per Chapter RCW 42.24.180.

Section 2. Payment of the sum of \$34,642,123.71 on City General Salary Fund mechanical warrants numbered 51177380 – 51178123 plus manual warrants, agencies warrants, and direct deposits numbered 120001 – 130955 representing Gross Payrolls for payroll ending date March 12, 2013 as detailed in the Payroll Summary Report for claims against the City which were audited by the Auditing Committee and reported by said committee to the City Council March. 21, 2013 consistent with appropriations heretofore made for such purpose from the appropriate Funds, is hereby approved.

Section 3. That any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this ordinance is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its approval by the Mayor, but if not approved and returned by the Mayor within ten days after presentation, it shall take effect as provided by Seattle Municipal Code Section 1.04.020.



AN ORDINANCE related to the creation of the Office of the Community Police Commission within the Executive Department; amending Ordinance 124058 by establishing a budget control level, position authority and appropriations for the 2013 fiscal year; amending Section 1 of Ordinance 124021; creating new sections in Chapter 3.14 of the Seattle Municipal Code; and amending Section 4.13.010 of the Seattle Municipal Code to exempt a position from the Civil Service system; all by a 2/3 vote of the City Council.
