BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection A of Section 3.02.125 of the Seattle Municipal Code, which section was

last amended by Ordinance 123900, is amended as follows:

A. The filing fee for a case before the City Hearing Examiner is \$85.00, with the
