30	WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature, by enacting RCW 47.01.402, endorsed the
31	replacement of the Alaskan Way Viaduct with the Tunnel as the preferred alternative and
32	authorized state funding; and
33	WHEREAS, the State subsequently created and implemented the Alaskan Way Viaduct and
34	Seawall Replacement Program to construct the Tunnel together with improvements to
