ORDINANCE NO. 12830.

An Ordinance vacating the alley between blocks 72 and 73, Denny & Hoyt's Supplemental Addition to the City of Seattle.

Whereas, There has been presented to the City Council the petition (File No. 28094) of the Bryant Lumber & Shingle Mill Co., the owners of more than two-thirds of the private property abutting on the alley sought to be vacated, praying for the vacation of the alley between blocks 72 and 73, Denny & Hoyt's Supplemental^(?) Addition to the City of Seattle; and

Whereas, all the steps and proceedings required by law and by Resolution of the City Council for the vacation of said alley have been taken and carried out;

Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the alley between blocks 72 and 73, Denny & Hoyt's Supplemental Addition, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Sec. 2 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from
and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; other-
wise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the
provisions of the City Charter.
