An ordinance providing for the laying off, extending and establishing of Harvard Avenue North, in the City of Seattle, as a public street and highway, over and across certain lots of Blocks Thirty-seven (37) and Forty-three (45), Denny-Fuhrman Addition to The City of Seattle, and providing for the taking and damaging of land and other property necessary therefor, and for the ascertainment and payment of the just compensation to be made for the private property to be taken or damaged for said purpose, and for an assessment upon the property benefited for the purpose of making such compensation.

WHEREAS public necessity and convenience demand that Harvard Avenue North, in The City of Seattle, be laid off, extended and established as a public street and highway; and

WHEREAS, the same will be of special benefit to certain lands and other premises situated in the vicinity of the proposed street; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SKATTLE, AS FOLLOWS: --

Section 1. That Harvard Avenue North, in The City of Seattle, be and the same is hereby laid off, extended and establish -ed as a public street and highway over and across certain lots in Block Thirty-seven (37) and Block Forty-three (43), Denny-Fuhrman Addition to The City of Seattle, more particularly described as follows:--

Beginning at a point on the Easterly marginal line of Block Thirty-seven (37), Denny-Fuhrman Addition to The City of Seattle, where said line is intersected by the West line of Harvard Avenue North, produced, said point being seventy-one and eighty-two hundredths (71.82) feet Northerly from the South-east corner of said Block, and running thence North along said West line of Harvard Avenue North, produced, a distance of four and hundred eighty-two and eighty-seven hundredths (482.87) feet, to a point on the North-

erlyline of said Block; thence Easterly along said Northerly line a distance of eighty-four and fifty-five hundredths (84.55) feet, to a point on the East line of Harvard Avenue North produced; thence South, along said East line of Harvard Avenue North produced, a distance of two hundred ninety-nine and seventy-two hundredths (299.72) feet, to a point on the Easterly line of said Block; thence Southerly along said Easterly line, a distance of one hundred sixty-two and forty-six hundredths (162.46) feet, to the place of beginning.

Also, beginning at the South-west corner of Block Fortythree (43). Denny-Fuhrman Addition to The City of Seattle, and
running thence Easterly along the Southerly line of said Block, a
distance of fifty-seven and sixty-six hundredths (57.66) feet,
to a point on the East line of Harvard Avenue North produced;
thence North, along said East line, produced, a distance of one
hundred twenty-four and eighty-nine hundredths (124.89) feet, to a
point on the Westerly line of said Block; thence Southerly along
said Westerly line, a distance of one hundred ten and seventy-nine
hundredths (110.79) #feet, to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That all lands, rights and privileges and other peperty property within the limits of the above bounded and described tracts are hereby condemned and appropriated to the public use for the purpose of a public street and highway forever, and the same to be taken and appropriated only after just compensation has been made or paid into Court for the owner in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is bereby authorized and directed to file in the Superior Court of the State of Washington, for the County of King, in the name of The City of Seattle, a petition complying with the requirements of the laws of the State of Washington, and praying that just compensation to be made for the private property to be taken or damaged for the purpose of laying off, extending and establishing of Harvard Avenue North, as provided in Section one (1) hereof, be ascertained by a jury, or byt the Court, in case a jury be waived.

Section 4. An assessment shall be made in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Washington for the purpose of raising the amount necessary to pay the compensation and damages which shall be awarded for the property taken as aforesaid, and for the costs of the proceedings, including the cost of making and collecting such assessment, and such assessment shall be made subject to the provisions of said laws upon all property specially benefited.

Any part of the compensation, damages or costs that is not finally assessed against said property benefited shall be paid from the General Fund of The City of Seattle.

For the purpose of said special assessment, a supplementary petition shall be filed in said court, and all other acts and proceedings necessary for the making, completion and collection of said assessment shall be taken and done as provided by the laws of the State of Washington.

Sec. 5 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the
