ORDINANCE NO. 13809

An Ordinance accepting a deed of conveyance from Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Company of Washington to The City of Seattle of a strip of land one hundred (100) feet in width and eight hundred and six and one-tenth (806.1) feet in length, the same being all of lot six (6) and the north forty (40) feet of lot seven (7) in block three hundred seventy-three (373), Seattle Tide Lands.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That The City of Seattle hereby accepts the deed of conveyance executed on the 16th day of May, 1906 by Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul Railway Company of Washington, to the following described lots, tracts and parcels of land situate, lying and being in The City of Seattle, King County, State of Washington, to-wit:

A strip of land one hundred (100) feet in width and eight hundred and six and one-tenth (806.1) feet in length, the same being all of lot six (6) and the north forty (40) feet of lot seven (7), in block three hundred and seventy-three (373), Seattle Tide Lands.
