## ORDINANCE NO. 14112

An Ordinance providing for the condemnation and appropriation of certain lots, blocks and tracts of land in and adjoining the City of Seattle, for public use, and particularly for use as a reservoir site in connection with the municipal water system, and previding for the ascertainment and payment of the just compensation to be made for the private property to be taken or damaged for said purpose, and for the making of such compensation.

WHEREAS, public necessity demands that a reservoir be constructed in the location hereinafter specified; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all the lands, rights and privileges and other property within the limits of the following bounded and described tracts: of land, are hereby condemned and appropriated to the public use for the purpose of constructing on said land a reservoir to be used in connection with the municipal water system, and said lands to be taken and appropriated only after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owners in the manner provided by law. The particular description of the lands hereinabove referred to is as follows, to-

- (1) In Maple Leaf Addition to Green Lake Circle, situated in King County, State of Washington: All of Blocks Three (3), X Four (4), Thirteen (13) and Fourteen (14), in said addition.
  - (2) In Thomas' Division of the Green Lake Addition, situated in Section Five (5), Township 25 North, Range 4 East, W. M.: All of Blocks One (1) and Two (2), in said division.
  - (3) All of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast E/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section Five (5), Township 25 North, Range 4 East, W. M., being Ten (10) acres, more or less.

Section 2. That the Corporation Counsel be and he hereby is authorized and directed to file in the Superior Court of the State authorized and directed to file in the Superior Court of the State of Washington for the County of King, in the name of the City of Seattle, a petition complying with the requirements of the laws of the State of Washington, and praying that just compensation to be made for the property to be taken or damaged for the purpose above set for the property to be taken or damaged for the purpose above set forth, as provided in Section One hereof, "be ascertained by a jury forth, as provided in Section One hereof, "be ascertained by a jury or by the court in case a jury be waived."

Section 3. That the damages awarded for the property taken, as provided in Section One hereof, together with the costs of the proceedings, shall be paid from the General Fund of the City of Seattle.
