ORDINANCE NO., 16415

AN ORDINANCE providing for the laying off, opening, widening, extending and establishing of East Pike Street, in the City of Seattle, from East Madison Street to Minor Avenue; and providing for the taking and damaging of land and other property necessary therefor; and for the ascertainment and payment of the just compensation to be made for the private property to be taken or damaged for said purpose; and for an assessment upon the property benefited for the purpose of making such compensation.

WHEREAS: Public necessity and convenience demand that East Pike Street, in the City of Seattle, be laid off, opened, widened, extended and established, as a public street and highway, from East Madison Street to Minor Avenue; and

WHEREAS: the same will he of special benefit to certain lands and other premises situated in the vicinity of the proposed street: NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That East Pike Street, in the City of Seattle,
be and the same is hereby laid off, opened, widened, extended and
established as a public street and highway from East Madison Street
to Minor Avenue, over and across certain lots, blocks, tracts and
parcels of land, in said City, more particularly described as follows,
to-wit:-

All those portions of the following described lots, blocks, tracts and parcels of land, lying between the center line of East Pike Street, as now laid off between Boylston Avenue and East Madison Street, and a line Forty-one (41) feet northerly from and parallel therewith:

In John H. Nagle's Addition to the City of Seattle:
Lots One (1) and Twelve (12), Block Ten (10)
Lots One (1) and Twelve (12), Block Eleven (11)
Lot One (1), Block Fourteen (14)
Lot Eleven (11), Block Fifteen (15)

In John H. Nagle's Second Addition to the City of Seattle:

Lots One (1) and Twelve (12), Block Twelve (12).

Lots One (1) and Twelve (12), Block Thirtsen (13).

Lot Twelve (12), Block Fourteen (14).

In Anderson's Supplemental Plat of John H. Nagle's Addition to the City of Seattle:

Lot One (1), Block Nine (9).

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In Sadman Home Addition to the City of Seattle: Block One (1) Lots One (1) and Two (2), Block Two (2).

In Union Addition to the City of Seattle: Lots Eight (8) and Nine (9), Block Four (4).

In Seneca Street Addition to the City of Seattle.
Lots Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10) and Eleven (11).

In Sackman Homa Addition to the City of Seattle. Lots One (1) and Ten (10), Block Four (4).

All those portions of the following described lots, blocks, tracts, or parcels of land, lyingbetween the center line of East Pike Street as now laid off from Boylston Avenue to the angle point between Bellevue Avenue and Minor Avenue, and a line Thirty-six (36) feet northerly from and parallel therewith:

In Union Addition to the City of Seattle:

Lots Eight (8) and Seven (7), Block Seven (7).

Lots Eight (8) and Seven (7), Block Twelve (12).

Lot Seven (7), Block Fifteen (15).

the north line of East Pike Street, a distance of Minety and two
tenths (90.2) feet to a point; thence north-westerly along a curve

to the right, having a radius of Nine and Eight Tenths (9.8) feet, through an arc of Ninety (90) degrees, to a point on the east line of Boylston Avenue, said point being Seventeen and Eight tenths (17.8) feet north of the south-west corner of said Lot Seven (7); thence south along the east margin of Boylston Avenue, a distance of Seventeen and Eight-tenths (17.8) feet to the south-west corner of said Lot Seven (7); thence east along the north margin of East pike Street a distance of One Hundred (100) feet to the point of beginning.

All that portion of Lot One (1), Block Six (6), Union Addition to the City of Sea tle, more particularly described as follows:

Reginning at the north-east corner of said tot One (1); thence west along the south margin of East Pike Street, a distance of One undred (100) feet to the north-west corner of said Lot One (1); thence south along the west line of said Lot One (1) a distance of Ten (10) feet; thence east along a line ten (10) feet southerly from and parallel with the south margin of East Pike Street, a distance of Eighty-six and Eight One-hundredths (86.08) feet to a point; thence along a curve to the right, having a radius of Thirteen and Minety-two One-hundredths (13.92) feet, through an arc of Minety (90) degrees, to a point on the west margin of Boylston Avenue; thence north along the west margin of Boylston Avenue, a distance of Twenty-three and Minety-two One-hundredths (23.92) feet to the point of beginning.

All that portion of Lot Seven (7), Block Three (3), in the Replat of Twelfth Avenue Addition to the City of Seattle, more particularly described as follows:

Reginning at the south-westerly corner of said not Seven (7), thence north-westerly along the easterly margin of Minor Avenue, a distance of Ten (10) feet; thence north-casterly along a line Ten (10) feet north-westerly from and parallel with the north-westerly Margin of East nike Street, a distance of Eighty-one and Ninety-five One-hundredths (81.95) feet, to a point; thence along a line Six (6) feet north from and parallel with the north margin of East Pike Street, a distance of Twenty-nine and Ninety-three One-hundredths (29.98) feet to the east line of said not Seven (7); thence south along the east line of said not Seven (7); thence south north margin of East pike Street a distance of Twenty and Seventy-one One-hundredths (20.71) feet to the angle point; thence southwesterly along the north-westerly margin of East pike Street a distance of Eighty-six and Fifty-three One-hundredths (86.53) feet to the point of beginning.

All that portion of Lot Six (6), Block Four (4), Replat of
Twelfth Avenue Addition to the City of Seattle, described as follows:
Beginning at the north-cast corner of said not Six (6); thence
west along the south margin of East pike Street, a distance of Ninetyseven and One-tenth (97.1) feet to the angle point; thence southwesterly along the south-easterly margin of East Pike Street, a distance of Seven and Eighty-five One-hundredths (7.85) feet to the west
line of said Lot Six (6); thence south along the west line of said
Lot Six (6), a distance of Eleven and Eighty-three One-hundredths
(11.83) feet to a point; thence north-easterly along a line Ten (10)
feet south-easterly from and parallel with the south-easterly margin
of East pike Street, a distance of Eleven and Twenty-seven One-hundredths (11.27) feet to the angle point; thence east along a line
Ten (10) feet southerly from and parallel with the south margin of
East Pike Street a distance of Ninety-four and Two-tenths (94.2)
feet to the west margin of Bellevue Avenue; thence north along the
west margin of Bellevue Avenue, a distance of Ten (10) feet to the
point of beginning.

All that portion of Lot One (1), Block Four (4), Replat of Twelfth Avenue Addition to the City of Seattle, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the north-westerly corner of said Lot One (1), thence north-easterly along the south-easterly margin of East Pike Street, a distance of Sixty-nine and Three tenths (69.3) feet to the north-easterly corner of said Lot One (1), thence south along the east line of Said Lot One (1), a distance of Eleven and Eighty-three One-hundredths (11.65) feet; thence south-westerly along a line Ten (10) f et south-easterly from and parallel with the south-easterly margin of East Pike Street, a distance of Sixty-two and Minety-eight One-hundredths (62.98) feet to the north-easterly margin of Minor Avenue; thence north-westerly along the north-easterly margin of Minor Avenue a distance of Ten (10) feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That all the lands, rights and privileges and other property within the limits of the above bounded and described tracts are hereby comdemned and appropriated to the public use for the purpose of a public street, and the same to be taken and appropriated only after just compensation has been made or paid into Court for the owners in the manner provided by law.

Section 3. That the corporation Counsel be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to file in the Superior Court of King County, State of Washington, a petition in the name of the City of Seattle, praying that the just compensation to be made for the private property to be taken or damaged for the purpose of laying off, opening, widening, extending and establishing East Pike Street, in the City of eattle, from East Madison Street to Minor Avenue, as provided in Section One (1) hereof, be ascertained by a jury or by the Court, in case a jury be waived.

Section 4. An assessment shall be made in the manner provided by the laws of the State of Washington for the purpose of raising the amount necessary to pay the compensation and damages which shall be awarded for the property taken as aforesaid, and for the costs of the proceedings, including the cost of making and colleting such assessment, and such assessment shall be made subject to the pro-

visions of said laws upon all property specially benefited.

Any part of the compensation, damages or costs that is not finally assessed against said property benefited shall be paid from the General Fund of the City of Seattle.

For the purpose of said special assessment, a supplementary petition shall be filed in said court, and all other acts and proceedin s necessary for the making, completion and collection of said assessment, shall be taken and done asprovided by the laws of the State of Washington.
