ORDINANCE NO. 17682

AN ORDINANCE appropriating money from the General Fund for the purpose of constructing a bulkhead in front of Lot eight (8), Block Forty-one (41), Mercer's Second Addition to the City of Seattle, same being known as the Greer property, and located at the north-east corner of Fourth Avenue North and Ward Street, and authorizing the Mayor and City Comptroller to draw, and the City Treasurer to pay, a warrant in favor of W. H. Cole and H. L. Chase for said sum in payment therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred Eighty-seven Dollars (\$187.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, be, and the same is, hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose of constructing a bulkhead in front of Lot Eight (8), Block Forty-one (41), Mercer's Second Addition to the City of Seattle, same being known as the Greer property, and located at the north-east corner of Fourth Avenue North and Ward Street.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Comptroller be, and they are, hereby, authorized and directed to draw, and the City Treasurer to pay, a warrant on the General Fund, in the sum of One Hundred Eighty-seven Dollars (\$187.00), in favor of W. H. Cole and H. L. Chase, in payment therefor.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.
