ORDINANCE NO. 17842

4 AN ORDINANCE providing for the condemnation and appropriation  
5 of certain real estate in the city of Seattle for park  
and parkway purposes.

6 WHEREAS, the Park Board of the city of Seattle, in  
7 writing, has designated the property hereinafter mentioned  
8 as property to be acquired for park and parkway purposes  
9 in the city of Seattle, and has requested the city council  
10 to pass an Ordinance authorizing and directing the city of  
11 Seattle to condemn the same for park and parkway purposes,  
12 and to ascertain what, if any damages, will be occasioned to,  
13 or suffered by, the adjoining property by the converting of  
14 said property into a park and parkway.

15 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE as follows:

16 Section 1. That the real estate, situated in the city  
17 of Seattle, King County, Washington, hereinafter described, be  
18 condemned, taken and appropriated by the city of Seattle,  
19 for the purpose of a park and parkway, to-wit:

20 Commencing at a point on the south boundary line of Burke's  
21 Second Addition to the city of Seattle which point is the  
22 center line of 34th Avenue South; running thence westerly  
23 50 feet to a point on the south line of said Burke's Second  
24 Addition fifteen feet westerly of the westerly line of said  
25 34th Avenue South; thence northerly parallel to and fifteen  
26 feet distant from said westerly line of said 34th Avenue  
27 South, to Frink Park in said Burke's Second Addition; thence  
28 easterly along the northerly line of King Street a distance of  
29 one hundred feet; thence southerly parallel to and fifteen feet  
30 distant from 34th Avenue South to the southerly line of  
said Burke's Second Addition, and thence westerly to the

point of beginning.

Sec. 2. That all the lands, rights and privileges and other property within the limits of the above bounded and described tracts, lots or parcels of land are hereby condemned and appropriated to the public use for the purpose of a park and parkway, and the same to be taken and appropriated only after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owners in the manner provided by law.

Sec. 3. That the Corporation Counsel is hereby authorized and instructed to take the necessary steps for such condemnation and to prosecute actions and proceedings to condemn and appropriate the land and property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Sec. 4. That the compensation therefor shall be made from the Park Fund of the city of Seattle.

Section 5 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.
