# ORDINANCE NO. 18109

AN ORDINANCE providing for the laying off, widening, extending, altering and establishing of Western Avenue, in the City of Seattle, as a public street and highway, over and across certain lots, blocks, tracts and parcels of land in said City; and providing for the changing and establishing of the grades of Western Avenue, from the north margin of Seneca Street to the south margin of Denny W ay; and Pike Place and Western Avenue, from the north margin of Pike Street, as widened, to the south margin of Virginia Street; and providing for the taking and damaging of all lands and other property necessary in the laying off, widening, extending, altering and establishing of said Western Avenue and Pike Place, and of the ap roaches to said streets and avenues, in conformity with such established grades, and in the construction of the necessary slopes for cuts and fills upon the real property abutting on said streets and avenues, and approaches thereto, and providing for the ascertainment and payment of the just compensation to be made for the property and property rights taken or damaged for such purposes, and for an assessment upon the property benefited for the purpose of making such compensation and paying the cost of such proceedings, and repealing all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

WHEREAS, public necessity demands that Western Avenue be laid off, widened, extended, altered and established, from point Seven and thirty-two one-hundredths (7.32) feet south of the south line of Pine Street, to a point One hundred and twenty (120) feet north of the north margin of Virginia Street; and that the grades of Western Avenue, from the north margin of Seneca Street, to the south margin of Denny Way; and Pike Place and Western Avenue, from the north margin of Pike Street, as widened, to the south margin of Virginia Street, be changed and established, and said streets and Epproaches thereto, be graded in conformity with such grades; and

WHEREAS, such improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property, Now, Therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Western Avenue, in the City of Seattle, from a point Seven and thirty-two one-hundredths (7.32) feet south of the south margin of Pine Street, to a point One hundred and wenty (120) feet north of the north margin of Virginia Street, be, and the same is hereby laid off, widened, extended and established as a public street and highway over and across certain lots, blocks, tracts and parcels of land, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

That in the construction of the necessary slopes for cuts and fills, upon the property abutting upon said street, and approaches thereto in the grading and regrading of said street, and approaches thereto, in accordance with the grades established herein, knowskyrozobes thereto, each cut shall be carried back into

and extend upon the abutting real property one (1) foot, for each foot in depth of cut, and each fill shall be carried back and extend upon the abutting real property one and one-half  $(1\frac{1}{2})$  feet for each foot of elevation of fill.

Section 3. That all the lands, rights, privileges and other property necessary to be taken, used or damaged in the grading and regrading of said named streets, avenues and places, to-wit:

Western Avenue, from the north margin of Seneca Street to the south margin of Denny Way; and Pike Place, from the north margin of Pike Street, as widened, to the south margin of Virginia Street; and in the grading and regrading of the approaches to said streets, avenues and places, to such distances back from said streets, not exceeding Two hundred fifty-six (256) feet. avenues and places, as may be necessary in conformity with the grades established in Section Two (2) hereof; and in the construction of the necessary slopes for cuts and fills, upon the real property abutting upon said streets, avenues and places, and approving thereto, are hereby condemned to the public use for the purpose of making such charge of grade, and in the construction of the necessary slopes for cuts and fills upon the real property abutting upon said streets, avenues and places, and approaches thereto, in the grading and regrading of the same The said lands, rights, privileges and other property to \* be taken and appropriated only after just compensation has been made or paid into Court for the owners in the manner prescribed by law.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to take the necessary steps for such condemnation and to prosecute the actions and proceedings necessary to condemn and appropriate the property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordiname.

Section 5. An assessment shall be made in the manner provided by law, for the purpose of raising the amount necessary to pay the compensation and damages which shall be awarded for the property taken or damaged as aforesaid; and for the cost and making and collecting such assessment, and said assessment shall be made subject to the provisions of said laws upon all the property specially benefited.

Any part of the compensation, damages or costs that is not finally assessed against said property benefited, shall be paid from the General Fund of The City of Seattle.

Section 6. That all ordinances, and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter,
