ORDINANCE NO. 18650

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the Board of Public Works to enter into a contract with the Home for Homeless Women and Children, located at No. 705 Twenty-fifth Avenue South, in the City of Seattle, for the care of such homeless women and children as may be a charge against the City of Seattle, and appropriating the sum of seventy-five (75) dollars per month from the General Fund to be paid said Home for said services.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract, for the period of one year, with the Home for Homeless Women and Children, located at No. 705 Twenty-fifth Avenue South in the City of Seattle, for the care of such homeless women and children as may be a charge against the City of Seattle during such period, said contract to cover the period from April 1, 1908 to April 1, 1909, April 1, 1908 being the date of the expiration of the contract entered into with said home under authority of Ordinance No. 15939, approved May 10, 1907, and that the sum of seventy-five (75) dollars per month be and the same is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to be paid said Home monthly as other bills against the City of Seattle are paid.

Section 2 This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall become a law and take effect as provided by the city charter.
