Ordinance No-19027

AN ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of the alley in Block Twelve (12), Capitol Hill Addition, Division No. 3, to The City of Seattle, being the alley from East Prospect Street to East Ward Street, between Fourteenth Avenue North and Fifteenth Avenue North, by paving the same with vitrified brick or asphalt, laid upon a proper concrete foundation, together with such sewers, with their appurtenances, as may be necessary for the proper drainage of said district, in accordance with resolution No. 1494 of The City Council of The City of Seattle;

and providing for the payment therefor by the mode of "Immediate Payment," as provided by the laws of the State of Washington and the charter and ordinances of the City of Seattle.

Be it ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That the alley in Block Twelve (12), Capitol Hill Addition Division No. 3, to The City of Seattle, being the alley from East Prospect Street to East Ward Street, between Fourteenth Avenue North and Fifteenth Avenue North, be improved by paving the same with vitrified brick or asphalt, laid upon a proper concrete foundation, together with such sewers, with their appurtenances, as may be necessary for the proper drainage of said district,

according to the plans and specifications prepared under the direction of the city engineer and on file in the office of the Department of Public Works; and that an assessment be levied and collected upon all lots and parcels of land benefited by such improvement to defray the cost and expense thereof, which assessment shall become a first lien upon the property liable therefor. Said improvement shall be made by contract, to be let to the lowest and best bidder therefor by the Board of Public Works; and that said board is hereby authorized and directed forthwith to procure bids therefor and to enter into a contract for said improvement in the name of the city.

Section 2. That there is hereby established a local improvement district, to be designated as "Local Improvement District No. 1425," which said district is described as follows:

"All the property abutting, adjacent or proximate to said portion of said alley specially benefited by such improvement. The property deemed to be specially benefited by this improvement shall include all the property between the termini of such improvement on said alley included herein, and shall be all the property lying between the marginal lines of said alley and extend back therefrom to the full depth of all lots and blocks abutting on said alley

to such distance back from the marginal lines thereof as prescribed by the City Charter."

The property included within said local improvement district, and none other, shall be deemed to be and shall be the property specially benefited by said improvement; and the total cost and expense of the improvement herein ordered, including all necessary incidental expenses, shall be defrayed by the collection of a special assessment upon the property included in said local improvement district.

which assessment shall be made upon said property in all respects as provided by the laws of the State of Washington and the charter and ordinances of the City of Seattle.

Section 3. That the mode of making payment for said local improvement shall be by the mode of "Immediate Payment," as defined by said laws and ordinances, and an assessment roll shall be prepared and reported to the city council, and other proceedings had thereon, as are prescribed by said mode of "Immediate Payment."

Section 4. That said improvement shall be made under the supervision of the Board of Public Works, which board is hereby ordered to proceed with said improvement.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force ^{THIRTY DAYS} from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the City Charter.
