ORDINANCE NO. 19318

AN ORDINANCE vacating a portion of Market Street and Twenty-fourth Avenue Northwest, in the city of Seattle, on the petition of W. H. Vernon, and others.

Whereas, W. H. Vernon, and others, have petitioned the City Council of the City of Seattle for the vacation of a portion of Market Street and Twenty-fourth Avenue Northwest, in the city of Seattle; said petitioners being the owners of more than two-thirds of the private property abutting on that portion of the streets sought to be vacated; and

Whereas, due notice of the time and place of the hearing on said petition has been given in the manner provided by law; and

Whereas, said petition was duly granted by the City Council on the 14th day of September, 1908;

Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following portion of Market Street and Twenty-fourth Avenue Northwest, in the City of Seattle, be and the same is hereby vacated;

Beginning at the intersection of the northerly line of Tract No. Forty-nine (49), Farmdale Homestead and the west line of Twenty-fourth Avenue Northwest, thence northwesterly along the northerly line of said tract a distance of one and fifty-five hundredths (1.55) feet to a point on the south line of Market Street; thence East along the South line of Market Street produced a distance of one and forty-two hundredths (1.42) feet; thence south along the West line of Twenty-fourth Avenue Northwest produced a distance of Fifty-nine hundredths feet (0.59) , to the point of beginning.

(To be used in all ordinances except emergency)

Section 7 This ordinance shall take effect thirty  
(30) days after its passage and approval, if approved by the  
Mayor; otherwise it shall become a law and take effect as provided  
by the city charter.
