ORDINANCE NO. 19335

AN ORDINANCE Providing for the laying off, opening, widening, extending and establishing of Woodland Park Avenue, in the City of Seattle, from West Green Lake Boulevard to North Eighty-fifth Street, and providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and carrying of land and other property necessary therefor; and providing that the payment for such improvement be made by special assessment upon property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law.

WHEREAS, Public necessity and convenience demand that Woodland Park Avenue, in the City of Seattle, from West Green Lake Boulevard to North Eighty-fifth Street, be laid off, opened, widened, extended and established as a public street and highway; and

WHEREAS, Said improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Woodland Park Avenue, in the City of Seattle, from West Green Lake Boulevard to North Eighty-fifth Street, be, and the same is hereby, laid off, opened, widened, extended and established as a public street and highway over and across the following described lots, blocks, and tracts of land, to-wit:

That portion of block six (6), Hillman's Lake Front, Division No. 1, an Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five North, Range Four (4) East, W. . .

That portion of block five (5), Hillman's Lake Front, Division No. 1, an Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. . .

That portion of block one (1), Hillman's Lake Front, Division No. 1, an Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45)

feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block nine (9), Kaufman's Addition to Green Lake Circle, an Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block eight (8), Kaufman's Addition to Green Lake Circle, an Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block five (5), Kaufman's Addition to Green Lake Circle, an Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block four (4), Kaufman's Addition to Green Lake Circle, an Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block one (1), Kaufman's Addition to Green Lake Circle, an Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block one (1), Osmer's First Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block four (4), Osner's First Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block five (5), Osner's First Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block five (5), Osner's Third Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block eight (8), Osner's Third Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of block nine (9), Osner's Third Addition to the City of Seattle, lying east of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet west from the center line of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.

That portion of Section Six (6), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M., lying south of Hollister's First Addition to the City of Seattle; north of West Green Lake Boulevard; east of the center line of said Section Six (6); and west of a line which is parallel to and distant forty-five (45) feet east from said center line.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the lots, blocks and tracts of land described in this ordinance, be, and the same are hereby, condemned, taken, damaged and appropriated to the public use for the purpose of a public street and highway forever.

Section 3. That the improvement provided for in this ordinance be paid for by special assessment upon property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law. Any part of the costs of said improvement that is not finally assessed against the property specially benefited, shall be paid from the General Fund of the City of Seattle.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance, and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.

(To be used in all ordinances except emergency)

Section 5 This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall become a law and take effect as provided by the city charter.
