ORDINANCE NO. 19668

AN ORDINANCE Providing for the laying off, extending and establishing of an alley in each of Blocks Fifty-six (56) and Fifty-seven (57), in Gilman Park, an Addition to the City of Seattle; and providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of land and other property necessary theretaking and providing that the payment for such improvement be made for; and providing that the payment for such improvement be made by special assessment upon projectly specially benefited, in the manner provided by law.

WHEREAS, Public necessity and convenience demand that an alley in each of Blocks Fifty-six (56) and Fifty-seven (57), alley in each of Blocks Fifty-six (56) and Fifty-seven (57), in Gilman Park, an addition to the City of Scattle, be laid in Gilman Park, an addition to the City of Scattle, be laid in Gilman Park, and established as public streets and highways; and

WHEREAS, Said improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an alley in each of Blocks Fifty-six (56) and Fifty-seven (57), in Gilman Park, an addition to the City of Seattle, be, and the same are hereby, laid off, extended and established as public streets and highways over and across certain lots, blocks and tracts of land in said city, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

That portion of Lots One (1) to Bifteen (15), inclusive, Block Fifty-six (50), Gilman Park, an addition to the City of Seattle, lying between the south line of said lots and a line which is parallel to and distant five (5) feet north from said south line.

That portion of Lots Sixteen (16) to Thirty (30), inclusive, Block Fifty-six (56), Gilman Park, an addition to the City of Seattle, lying between the north line of said lots and a line which is parallel to and distant five (5) feet south from said north line.

That portion of Lots one (1) to Twelve (12), inclusive, Block Fifty-seven (57), Gilman Park, an addition to the City

of Seattle, lying between the south line of said Lots, and a line which is parallel to and distant five (5) feet north from said wouth line.

That portion of Lots Thisteen (13) to Twenty-four (24), inclusive, Block Fifty-seven (57), Gilman Park, an addition to the City of Seattle, lying between the north line of said Lots and a line which is parallel to and distant five (5) feet south from said north line.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the lots, blocks and tracts of land described in this ordinance be, and the same are hereby, condemned, taken, damaged and appropriated to the public use for the purpose of a public street and highway forever.

Section 3. That the improvement provided for in this ordinance be paid for by special assessment upon property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law. Any part of
the costs of said improvement that is not finally assessed
against the property specially benefited shall be paid from
the General Fund of the City of Seattle.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance, and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment, in the manner provided by law.

(To be used in all ordinance except emergency)

Section 5 This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall become a law and take effect as provided by the city charter.
