ORDINANCE NO. 20541

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Chief of the Fire Department to incur an expenditure in the sum of five hundred (500) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, in wiring for the fire alarm system at the A-Y-P Exposition grounds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Chief of the Fire Department be and he is hereby authorized to incur an expenditure in the sum of five hundred (500) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the purpose of doing necessary wiring in connection with the installation of the fire alarm system at the A-Y-P Exposition grounds.

NOW, THEREFORE, by reason of the foregoing facts, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in which it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety that this ordinance shall become effective without delay.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
