ORDINANCE NO 20839

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the Board of Public Works to construct a detention and comfort station for the use of the Police Department and the public in the vicinity of the A-Y-P Exposition grounds, and appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Board of Public Works be and it is hereby authorized to construct a detention and comfort station for the use of the Police Department and the public at or near the A-Y-P Exposition grounds, and that the sum of one thousand (1,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general fund for such purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, by reason of the foregoing facts, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in which it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety that this ordinance shall become effective without delay.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
