ORDINANCE NO. 20991

AN ORDINANCE accepting the certificate of the Secretary of State of the United States of America as to the enactment of an Act entitled "An Act to grant to The City of Seattle, in the State of Washington, certain rights of way for sewer and street purposes through and along the military reservation of Fort Lawton, Washington, and through the reservations for the Lake Washington Canal".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Certificate of the Secretary of State of the United States of America, dated the 10th day of April, 1909, certifying a copy of an Act, entitled "An Act to grant to the City of Seattle, in the State of Washington, certain rights of way for sewer and street purposes through and along the military reservation of Fort Lawton, Washington, and through the reservations for the Lake Washington Canal", be and the same is hereby accepted and ordered placed of record.

(To be used for all Ordinances-except emergency.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
