ORDINANCE NO. 21039

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of one hundred and twenty-five (125) dollars from the general fund to be paid the City Comptroller for use in the purchase of postage for mailing official invitations to the A - Y - P. Exposition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the sum of one hundred and twenty-five (125) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general fund to be paid the City Comptroller for use in the purchase of postage for mailing official invitations issued by The City of Seattle to the Alaska-Yukon-Pacific Exposition, and that the Mayor and City Comptroller be and they are hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the general fund in the sum of one hundred and twenty-five (125) dollars in favor of the City Comptroller for such purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, by reason of the foregoing facts, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in which it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety that this ordinance shall become effective without delay.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
