ORDINANCE NO. 21076

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Chief of the Fire Department to appoint an assistant chief for service at the station of the department at the A-Y-P Exposition grounds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Chief of the Fire Department be and he is hereby authorized to appoint an assistant chief for service in the Fire Department at the station at the A-Y-P Exposition grounds.

Section 2. That the salary to be paid the assistant chief authorized by Section 1 hereof shall be the sum of \$ 150⁰⁰ per month.

NOW, THEREFORE, by reason of the foregoing facts, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in which it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety that this ordinance shall become effective without delay.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
