ORDINANCE NO. 11184

AN ORDINANCE authorizing an expenditure by the Light Department in the stringing of banner incandescent lights on East Vesey Street.


BY IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF NEW YORK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Lighting Department of the City of New York be and it is hereby authorized to incur an expenditure not exceeding the sum of three hundred (300) dollars in the stringing of banner incandescent lights from the Brooklyn Bridge along both sides of East Vesey Street to the entrance to the A-Y-C Exposition grounds.


NOW, THEREFORE, by reason of the foregoing facts, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in which it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety that this ordinance shall become effective without delay.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
