ORDINANCE NO. 22414

AN ORDINANCE providing for the taking and damaging of land and other property necessary as a site for a city hall, or other municipal buildings or purposes and for the ascertainment and payment of the just compensation to be made for the private property to be taken or damaged for said purpose.

WHEREAS, public necessity demands that certain real property be taken and damaged for the purpose of securing a site for a city hall or other municipal building or purposes for the City of Seattle;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all the following described real property, rights and privileges, in King County, State of Washington, be and the same is hereby declared to be necessary and essential as a site for a city hall or other municipal buildings or purposes for the City of Seattle, and that all of said real property and property rights and privileges, excepting such rights and privileges as have been especially reserved as tunnel rights for the Seattle and Montana Railroad Company, and the Northern Pacific Railway Company, be and the same are hereby condemned for said purpose, to-wit:

Lots two (2), three (3), six (6), and seven (7), block thirty-eight (38), C.D.Boren's Addition to the City of Seattle.

Section 2. That all of the lands, rights and privileges, (excepting such rights and privileges as have been especially reserved as tunnel rights for the Seattle and Montana Railroad Company, and the Northern Pacific Railway Company,) and other property within the above described and bounded tracts are hereby condemned and appropriated to the public use for the purpose of a site for a city hall, or other municipal buildings or purposes, and the same to be taken and appropriated only after just compensation has been made or paid into Court for the owner in the manner provided by law. Compensation for said property to be made from the General Fund of the City of Seattle.

Section 3. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file in the Superior Court of King County, Washington, in the name of the City of Seattle, a petition complying with the requirements of the laws of the State of Washington, and praying that just compensation to be made for the private property to be taken or damaged as aforesaid, as provided by Section 1 hereof, "be ascertained by a jury, or by the Court, in case a jury be waived".

(To be used for all Ordinances except emergency.)

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
