ORDINANCE NO. 23190

AN ORDINANCE Providing for the condemnation and appropriation of Lot Twenty-two (22) in Block Five (5), Edgewater Addition to the City of Seattle, for municipal purposes, and providing that the payment for said lot shall be made in equal amounts from the General Fund and the Water Fund of the City of Seattle;

WHEREAS, Public necessity and convenience demand that Lot Twenty-two (22), Block Five (5), Edgewater Addition to the City of Seattle, be condemned and appropriated for municipal purposes, and;

WHEREAS, Said improvement will be of general benefit to the City of Seattle; NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Lot Twenty-two (22) in Block Five (5), Edgewater Addition to the City of Seattle, be, and the same is, hereby condemned and appropriated for municipal purposes.

SECTION 2. That the Corporation Council be, and he is, hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law to condemn and appropriate the above described property for municipal purposes.

SECTION 3. That payment for the above described property be made in equal amounts from the General Fund and the Water Fund of the City of Seattle.

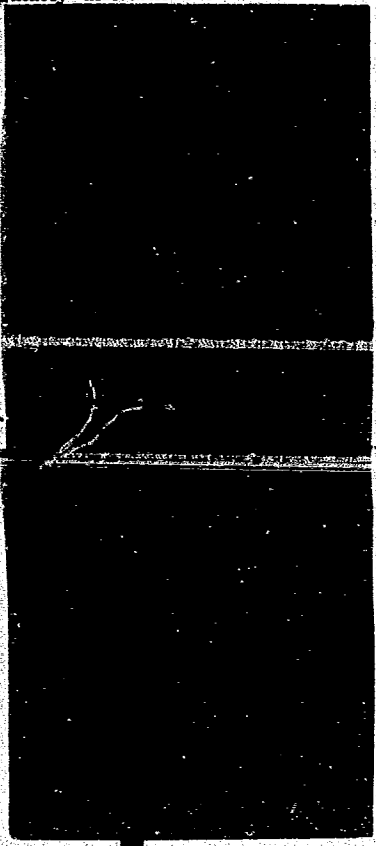
