ORDINANCE NO. 23342

AN ORDINANCE accepting a deed from the Adelpia College, a corporation, to the City of Seattle, dated the 28th day of April 1908, to

A certain tract of land in Lot four (4) of Section Twenty (20) Township Twenty-five (25) North of Range four (4) east of W. M. in the City of Seattle.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS TO WIT.

SECTION 1: That the deed dated the 28th day of April, 1908, to the City of Seattle, executed by The Adelpia College, to the following described property to wit:

That certain tract, piece or parcel of land in Lot four (4) of section Twenty (20), Township Twenty-five (25) North of Range four (4) east of W.M., being a part of Adelpia College Grounds, bounded and particularly described as follows, to wit: Commencing at a point on the west line of Delmar Park, an addition to the City of Seattle, distant eight hundred twenty-one and eighty-five one-hundredths feet (821.85) north of the south boundary of said Lot Four (4); and running thence northwesterly by a straight line one hundred seventy-four and eighty two one hundredths feet (174 82/100) more or less to a point distant eight hundred and seventy-nine and twenty-one one-hundredths feet (879 21/100) north and three hundred sixteen and thirty-six one hundredths feet (316.36) east from the southwest corner of said Lot four (4); thence northwesterly by a straight line two hundred forty-one and fifty-three one-hundredths feet (241 53/100) more or less, to a point distant one hundred thirty feet (130) east and ten hundred thirty-two and eighty-four one-hundredths feet (1032 84/100) north from the southwest corner of said lot four (4); thence northwesterly by a straight line one hundred sixty-five and ninety three one-hundredths feet (165 93/100) more or less to a point on the east margin of Eleventh Avenue North distant thirty feet (30) east and eleven hundred sixty-five and twenty-seven one-hundredths feet (1165 27/100) north from the southwest corner of said Lot four (4); thence south along the east margin of Eleventh Avenue North one hundred seventy-nine and fifty-nine one-hundredths feet (179 59/100); thence southeasterly by a straight line two hundred ninety seven feet (297) more or less, to a point distant seven hundred ninety-six and seventy-six one-hundredths feet (796 76/100) north and two hundred and fifty-nine and eighteen one-hundredths feet (259 18/100) east from the southwest corner of said Lot four (4); thence southeasterly by a straight line one hundred ninety four and forty-four one-hundredths feet (194 44/100) more or less to a point distant four hundred forty-one and eight-tenths feet (441 8/10) east and seven hundred thirty feet (730) north from the southwest corner of said lot four (4); thence southeasterly by a straight line one hundred ninety-four feet (194) more or less, to a point on the west line produced of said Delmar Park, five hundred forty feet (540) north and four hundred eighty-one and eight-tenths feet (481 8/10) east from the southwest corner of said Lot Four (4); thence north along said west line produced of said Delmar Park two hundred eighty-one and eighty-five one-hundredths feet (281 85/100) to the point or place of beginning; containing in all one and three tenths (1 3/10) acres more or less.

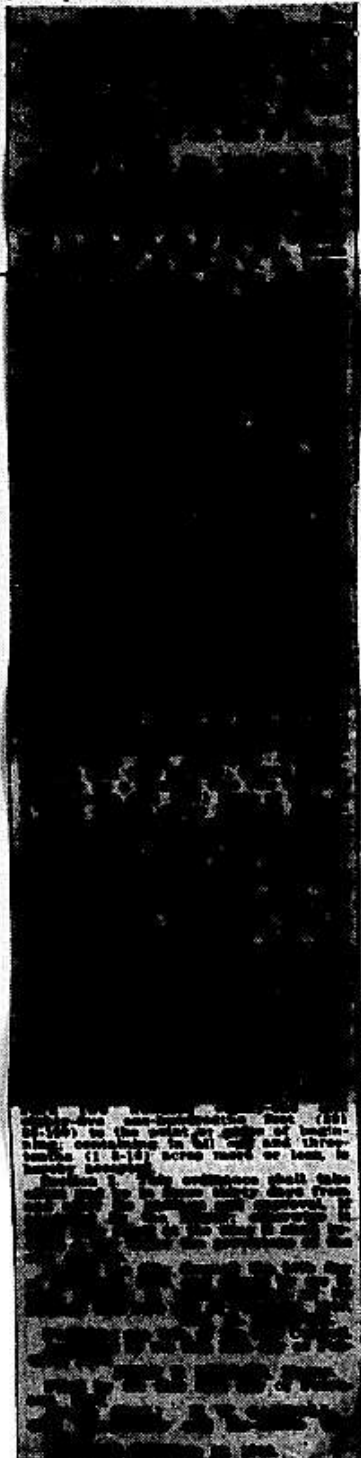

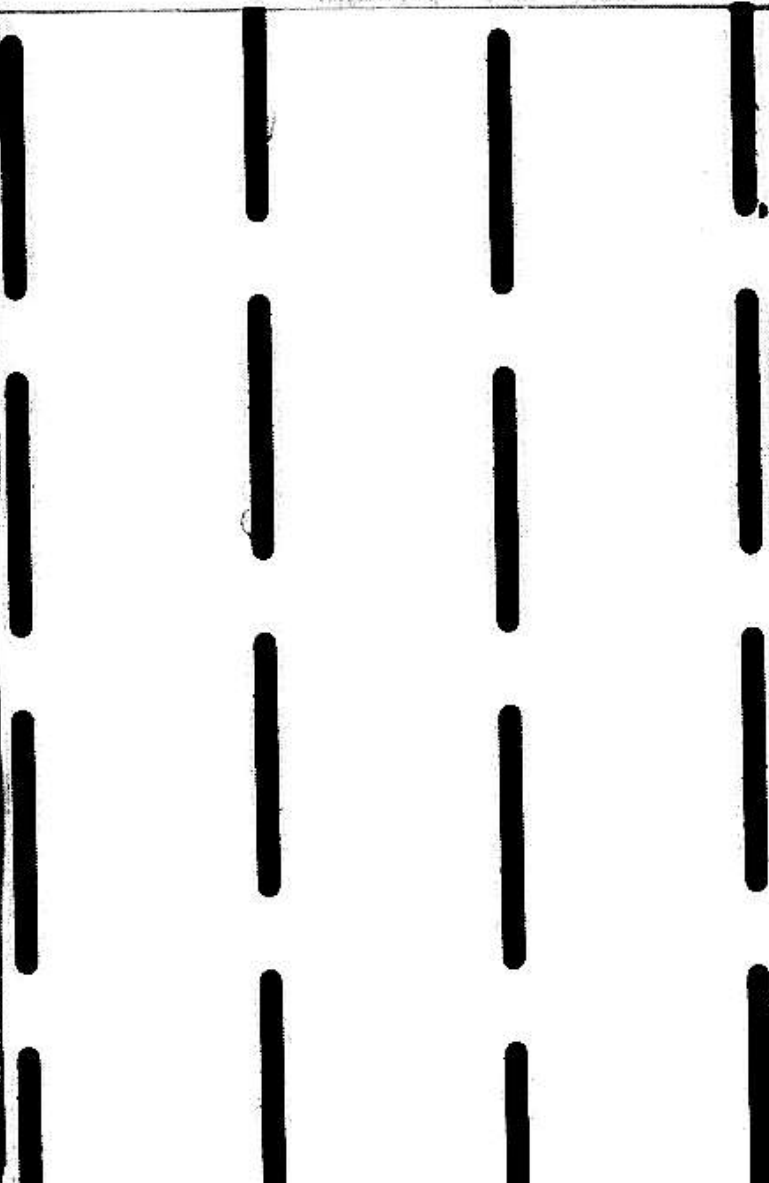
