ORDINANCE NO. 23575

An Ordinance of the City of Seattle accepting from Oregon and Washington Railroad Company, a corporation, a conveyance in compliance with Ordinance No.18030.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:-

Section 1. The City of Seattle does hereby accept and receive the deed made by the Oregon and Washington Railroad Company dated February 28th, 1910, (which said deed is a substitute for that certain deed executed on the 3rd day of September, 1908, and tendered to the City of Seattle on the 5th day of September, 1908), as provided under Ordinance numbered 18030, for bridge roadway purposes across the easterly seventy-five feet of Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Block 330, of Seattle Tide Lands, as described in said Ordinance 18030, in compliance and in accordance with the terms of said Ordinance; and the Comptroller of the City of Seattle is hereby directed to cause said deed to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of King County, Washington.



Section 2 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
