AN ORDINANCE vacating a portion of Pine Street on the petition of the Seattle Seamen's Friend Society.

Whereas, there has been presented to the City Council the petition (File No. 38841) of the Seattle Seamen's Friend Society asking for the vacation of a portion of Pine Street in the City of Seattle; and

Whereas, due notice of the time and place of hearing on said petition has been given in the manner provided by law, at which hearing said petition was duly granted;

Now Therefor ,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described portion of Pine Street, in the City of Seattle, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the south line of Pine Street and the west line of Western Avenue, as now widened; running thence westerly along the south line of Pine Street a distance of 117.76 feet to the alley between Western Avenue and Elliott Avenue; thence northerly along the east line of said alley produced a distance of 36 feet; thence easterly and parallel with the south line of Pine Street a distance of 106.72 feet to the west line of Western Avenue, and thence southerly along the westerly line of Western Avenue to the point of beginning,
