AN ORDINANCE Providing for the laying off, extending and establishing of an alley through Block One (1), Ballard Addition, to the City of Seattle; providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of land and other property necessary therefor; and providing that the payment for such improvement be made by special assessment upon property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law.

WHEREAS, Public accessibility and convenience demand that an alley be laid off, extended and established through Block One (1), Ballard Addition to the City of Seattle; and WHEREAS, said improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property; Now, Therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That an alley through Block One (1), Ballard Addition, to the City of Seattle, be and the same is hereby laid off, extended and established as a public alley and highway, over and across the following described tracts of land, to-wit:

The North five (5) feet of Lots twenty-five (25) to forty-eight (48) inclusive, in Block One (1), Ballard Addition to the City of Seattle.

The South five (5) feet of Lots One (1) to twenty-four (24) inclusive, in Block One (1), Ballard Addition to the City of Seattle.

SECTION 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property necessary to be used or damaged in the laying off, extending, and establishing of an alley through Block One (1), Ballard Addition, to the City of Seattle as described in Section One (1) hereof, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for said purposes; said land, rights, privileges and other property are to be taken, used and damaged only after just compensa

tion has been made or paid into Court, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 3. That the costs of the improvement provided for in this Ordinance shall be paid for by special assessment upon the property, specially benefited, lying within the limits of Block One (1), Ballard Addition to the City of Seattle.

SECTION 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, to condemn, appropriate, take and damage the land and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this Ordinance; and, also, to take such steps as are necessary to make such special assessment.

Section ... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
