AN ORDINANCE Providing for the laying off, widening, altering and establishing of West Florentia Street, from First Avenue West to Third Avenue West, all in the City of Seattle, as a public street and highway; providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of land and other property necessary therefor; and providing that the payment for such improvement be made by special assessment upon the property specially benefitted, in the manner provided by law.

WHEREAS, Public necessity and convenience demand that West Florentia Street, from First Avenue West to Third Avenue West, all in the City of Seattle, be laid off, widened, altered and established as a public street and highway, and

WHEREAS, Said improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That West Florentia Street, from First Avenue West to Third Avenue West, all in the City of Seattle, be and the same is hereby laid off, widened, altered and established as a public street and highway, over and across the following described piece, parcel or tract of land, to-wit:

That tract of unplatted land lying west of First Avenue West, east of Third Avenue West, south of the south margin of West Florentia Street and north of a line which is parallel to and distant thirty-three (33) feet south from said south margin.

SECTION 2: That all lands, rights, privileges and other property necessary to be taken, used or damaged in carrying out the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for said purpose.

SECTION 3. That the cost of the improvement provided for in this ordinance shall be paid for by special assessment upon the property specially benefitted, which lies south of West Florentia Street, north of West Fulton Street, produced, west of First Avenue west and east of Third Avenue West, in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance; and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
