ORDINANCE NO. 25542

AN ORDINANCE Providing for the condemnation, appropriation and taking of Lots Five (5), Six (6) and Seven (7), Block Forty-two (42), in D. T. Denny's Home Addition to the City of Seattle, for park purposes, and providing that the payment for the same be made from the City Park Fund.

WHEREAS, The Board of Park Commissioners has, in writing, designated Lots Five (5), Six (6) and Seven (7), Block Forty-two (42), in D. T. Denny's Home Addition to the City of Seattle, as property to be condemned, appropriated and taken for park purposes, and

WHEREAS, Public necessity and convenience demands the condemnation, appropriation, taking and use of said property for park purposes, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Lots Five (5), Six (6) and Seven (7), Block Forty-two (42), in D. T. Denny's Home Addition to the City of Seattle, and all rights, privileges and other property pertaining thereto, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated and taken for park purposes. Said property is to be appropriated and taken only after just compensation has been made or paid into court for the owner in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 2: That the payment for said property and property rights be made from the City Park Fund.

SECTION 3 That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings in the manner provided by law, ^{necessary} to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section *4* This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
