ORDINANCE NO. 25964

AN ORDINANCE vacating portions of certain streets and avenues in Burke's First Addition to the City of Seattle on the petition of the Seattle Lighting Company.

Whereas, there has been filed with the City Council the petition of the Seattle Lighting Company (File No. 41758) praying for the vacation of the following described portions of streets and avenues in Burke's First Addition to the City of Seattle, to-wit:

All that portion of North Twenty-ninth Street lying east of the west line of Burke Avenue extended to deep water in Lake Union not heretofore vacated; also all that portion of Burke Avenue lying south of the north line of North Twenty-ninth Street and extending to deep water in Lake Union; also all that portion of Northlake Avenue lying east of Wallingford Avenue and extending north to North Twenty-ninth Street;

said petitioner being the owner of more than two-thirds of the private property abutting on the portions of streets and avenues sought to be vacated; and

Whereas, due notice of the time and place of the hearing on said petition has been given in the manner provided by law, at which hearing said petition was duly granted by the City Council of the City of Seattle;

Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described portions of streets and avenues, to-wit:

All that portion of North Twenty-ninth Street lying east of the west line of Burke Avenue extended to deep water in Lake Union not heretofore vacated; also all that portion of Burke Avenue lying south of the north line of North Twenty-ninth Street and extending to deep water in Lake Union; also all that portion of Northlake Avenue lying east of Wallingford Avenue and extending north to North Twenty-ninth Street,
be and the same ^{are} hereby vacated.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
