ORDINANCE NO. 26365

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the Board of Public Works to construct a water main on Chelan Avenue, from Sixteenth Avenue Southwest to West Spokane Street; appropriating money to pay the cost thereof; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the existing water main on West Spokane Street where it crosses the channel of the West Waterway must be removed, and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a supply of water be continued to those parts of the City of Seattle now supplied by the above said watermain, and

WHEREAS, this supply of water may best be continued by a main to be laid on Chelan Avenue, from Sixteenth Avenue Southwest to West Spokane Street, and

WHEREAS, the present condition of the above said Chelan Avenue is such that a water main laid upon it will be of temporary use only and of no benefit to the abutting property; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Board of Public Works be, and it is hereby authorized and directed to construct a water main on Chelan Avenue, from Sixteenth Avenue Southwest to West Spokane Street with such submerged crossing, gates and fittings as may be necessary for its proper operation, in accordance with plans to be prepared by the City Engineer and approved by the said Board of Public Works.

Section 2: That the sum of eight thousand and no/100 (\$8000.00) dollars be, and the same is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund of the City of Seattle for the purpose set forth in Section one (1) hereof.

(To be used for Emergency Ordinances.)

NOW, THEREFORE, by reason of the foregoing facts, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in which it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety that this ordinance shall become effective without delay.

Section .3 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
