ORDINANCE ORDINANCE NO. 43786

No. 30323

AN ORDINANCE Providing for the laying off, widening, altering and establishing of Queen Anne Boulevard, between West Smith Street and Seventh Avenue West, all in the City of Seattle, as a public street and highway, and providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of land and other property necessary therefor; and providing that the payment of the cost of said improvement be made by special assessment upon the property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law.

WHEREAS, Public necessity and convenience demand that Queen Anne Boulevard, between West Smith Street and Seventh Avenue West, all in the City of Seattle, be laid off, widened, altered and established as a public street and highway, and

WHEREAS, said improvement will be of special benefit to certain land, premises and other property, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Queen Anne Boulevard, between West Smith Street and Seventh Avenue West, all in the City of Seattle, be and the same is hereby laid off, widened, altered and established as a public street and highway, over and across the following described lots, blocks or tracts of land, to-wit:

That portion of the West one-half of the Northwest one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Three (3) East, W.M., described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the northeast corner of said sub-division of said Section Twenty-four (24); thence south along the east line thereof a distance of four hundred forty-three and sixteen one-hundredths (443.16) feet to the south line of Gould's Queen Anne Scenic Addition to the City of Seattle; thence west along said south line, produced west, a distance of three and ninety-one one-hundredths (3.91) feet to a point on the east margin of Queen Anne Boulevard; thence north along said east margin a distance of three hundred and ninety-six one-hundredths (300.96) feet to the beginning of a curve to the left having a uniform radius of one hundred thirty-three (133) feet; thence northwesterly along the arc of said curve a distance of ninety-five and seventy five one-hundredths (95.75)

feet; thence north a distance of fifty-four and eleven one-hundredths (54.11) feet to a point on the north line of said subdivision of said section Twenty-four (24); thence east along said north line a distance of thirty-six and ninety-one one-hundredths (36.91) feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2: That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the lots, blocks or tracts of land described in Section One heretofore be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for ^{public} street purposes.

SECTION 3: That the cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid ~~for~~ by special assessment upon the property specially benefited.

SECTION 4: That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby, authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance; and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section . This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
