ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE placing certain property in Section Thirty-two (32), Township Twenty-six (26) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M., and Section Five (5), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M., under the jurisdiction of the Board of Park Commissioners of the City of Seattle, to be used for park purposes.

Be it ordained by the City of Seattle as follows:

Section 1. That the following property in Section Five (5), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M., be, and the same hereby is placed under the jurisdiction of the Board of Park Commissioners of the City of Seattle, to be used for park purposes, to-wit:

In Section Thirty-two (32), Township Twenty-six (26) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.,

- (1) - In Maple Leaf Addition to Green Lake Circle -
All of Block Three (3), all of Acres One (1), Two (2) and Three (3) in Block Four (4); Lots Four (4), Five (5) and Six (6) in Acres One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4) and Five (5), Block Fourteen (14); Lots Four (4), Five (5) and Six (6) in Acres One (1) and Two (2) and Lots Five (5) and Six (6) in Acre Three (3), Block Thirteen (13).

In Section Five (5), Township Twenty-five (25) North, Range Four (4) East, W. M.,

- (1) - In Thomas Division of Green Lake Addition -
All of Blocks One (1) and Two (2).

(2) - All of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said section, except the East Three Hundred Eight (308) feet thereof.

(3) - In Pitner's Third Division to Green Lake Addition to the City of Seattle, Washington, -
Lots One (1) to Ten (10) inclusive and Thirty-one (31) to Forty (40) inclusive in Blocks One, (1), Two (2) and Three (3).

(4) - In Green Lake Addition, Vacher's Division to the City of Seattle, Washington, -
All of Blocks One (1), Two (2) and Three (3), being the whole of said Addition.

(5) - In Wood's Green Lake Park Addition to the City of
Seattle, -
All of Block Twenty (20) and Lots Fourteen (14) to
Twenty-three (23) inclusive in Block Eleven (11).

(6) - In Perkins' Green Lake Addition to the City of Seattle
All of Blocks Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8).

Section 2. There is reserved to the City, the right to
erect and maintain such necessary standpipes, reservoirs, water towers
or other appurtenances of the water system as may be necessary, and
to carry across and underneath said ground such conduits for water-
mains, electric transmission, sewers or other public utilities, as
may be required by the necessities of public service

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3... This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
