southwestern^{ly} margin a distance of seventy-four and fifty-two one-hundredths (74.52) feet to a point on the north line of said lot; thence west along said north line a distance of ten and thirty one-hundredths (10.30) feet to the point of beginning.

That portion of Lot seven (7) described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the northwest corner of said lot; thence south along the west line thereof to the southwest corner of said lot; thence east along the south line thereof to the southeast corner of said lot; thence north along the east line thereof a distance of seven and fifty-five one-hundredths (7.55) feet to a point on the southwesternly margin of the public street and highway laid off and established by Ordinance No. 29062; thence northwesterly along said southwesternly margin a distance of eighty-five and eighty one-hundredths (85.80) feet to a point on the north line of said lot; thence west along said north line a distance of twenty-five and forty-five one-hundredths (25.45) feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the lots, blocks, and tracts of land described in Section 1 hereof, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged for public square purposes.

Section 3. That the cost of the land and other property described herein and the cost of the necessary condemnation proceedings shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefitted in the manner provided by law. ~~any part of the cost of~~ and that no part thereof shall be paid from the general fund or the city park fund of the City of ~~said land and other property and of the cost of the necessary~~ ~~condemnation proceedings~~ ~~be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefitted shall be paid from the City Park fund.~~ Seattle.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
