

ORDINANCE NO. 31403

AN ORDINANCE providing for the laying off, widening, altering and establishing of Lander Street, from Twelfth Avenue South to Fourteenth Avenue South, all in the City of Seattle; providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of land and other property necessary therefor; and providing that the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law.

WHEREAS, Public necessity and convenience demand that Lander Street, from Twelfth Avenue South to Fourteenth Avenue South be laid off, widened, altered and established as a public street and highway, and

WHEREAS, Said improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property. ... OW, THEREFORE,

RE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SMATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Lander Street, from Twelfth Avenue South to Fourteenth Avenue South, be and the same is hereby laid off, widened, altered and established as a public street and highway over and across the following lots, blocks or tracts of land, to-wit:

That portion of an unplatted tract of land in Hanford's Donation Claim, bying between the south line of Bayside Addition to the City of Seattle and the north line and said north line produced west of Block Forty (40) Charles E. Lee's Replat of Blocks Thirty-nine (39) and Forty (40), Hanford's Addition to South Seattle, now a portion of the City of Seattle, said unplatted tract of land more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the south line of Bayside Addition to the City of Seattle, said point being distant Fourteen
and Eighty-three one-hundredths (14.83) feet west from the
intersection of said south line and the center line of Fourteenth Avenue South on the north; thence west along said
south line a distance of Three Hundred Seventy-six and Ninetytwo One-hundredths (376.92) feet; thence south Forty-eight (48)

feet; thence east along a line which is distant Three and
Pifteen One-hundredths (3.18) feet north from and parallel
With the north line and said north line produced east of
Block Thirty-one (31), Hanford's Addition to South Seattle,
now a portion of the City of Seattle, a distance of One Hunnow a portion eand Eighty-two One-hundredths (121.32) feet;
thence south Five-tenths (.5) feet; thence east along a line

which is distant Two and Sixty-five One-hundredths (2.65)
which is distant Two and parallel with the north line of Block

now a portion of the City of Seattle, a distance of Two Hundred

That portion of an unplatted tract of land in Hanford's Donation Claim lying between the south line of Bayside Addition to the City of Scattle and the north line of Block Thirty-tion to the City of Scattle and the north line of Block Thirty-one (31), Hanford's Addition to South Seattle, now a portion of the City of Seattle, said unplatted tract of land more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the south line of Bayside Addition to the City of Senttle, said point being distant one hundred sixteen and twenty-five one-hundredths (116.25) feet east from the intersection of said south line and the center line of Twelfth Avenue South as platted in said addition, thence east along said south line a distance of one hundred twenty (120) feet; thence south forty-eight (48) feet; thence west along a line which is distant three and fifteen one-hundredths (3.15) feet north from and parallel with the north line of Block Thirty-one (31) Hanford's Addition to South Seattle, now

a portion of the city of Seattle, a distance of One Hundred Twenty (120) feet; thence north forty-eight (48) feet, to point of beginning.

The South Three and Twenty-five One-hundredths (3.25) feet of Block Four (4), Bayside Addition to the City of Seattle.

section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and otherproperty lying within the limits of the lots, blocks or tracts of land described in Section One (1) hereof, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and damaged of the street purposes.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by special assessment upon property specially benefited in the manner provided by law, and that no part thereof shall be paid from the General Fund of the City of Seattle.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the action and proceedings, in the marner provided by law, to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance; and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.
