ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to and regulating the wearing and use of hat pins in the City of Seattle, and providing penalties for violations.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to wear or use in the City of Seattle any hat pin or other instrument for the fastening or securing of hats or other head coverings, so that the sharp end of such hat pin or other instrument shall project more than one and one-quarter inches from the crown of such hat or head covering; or so that the same shall extend beyond the rim of such hat or covering, or so that the same shall extend or project in any manner from such hat or head covering as to be likely to, or in such manner as might, wound any person or thing or endanger life or property.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred(100) dollars, or imprisoned in the city jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or may be both fined and imprisoned.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 3 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
