ORDINANCE NO. 31783

AN ORDINANCE Providing for the laying-off, opening, widening, extending and establishing of Dawson Street from Thirty-seventh Avenue South to Thirty-ninth Avenue South; providing for the condemnation, appropriation, taking and damaging of land and other property necessary therefor; and providing that the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by special assessment upon the property specially benefited in the manner provided by law;

WHEREAS, Public necessity and convenience demand that Dawson Street, from Thirty-seventh Avenue South to Thirty-ninth Avenue South, be laid-off, opened, widened, extended and established as a public street and highway; and

WHEREAS, said improvement will be of special benefit to certain lands, premises and other property; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Dawson Street from Thirty-seventh Avenue South to Thirty-ninth Avenue South be and the same is hereby laid-off, opened, widened, extended and established over and across the following lots, blocks or tracts of land, to-wit:

The south twenty (20) feet of Tract eighteen (18),
Morningside Acre Tracts, an addition to the City of Seattle.

The south twenty (20) feet of Tract Twenty-nine (29),
Morningside Acre Tracts, an addition to the City of Seattle.

The north thirty (30) feet of Tract Nineteen (19),
Morningside Acre Tracts, an addition to the City of Seattle.

The north thirty (30) feet of Tract Twenty-eight (28),
Morningside Acre Tracts, an addition to the City of Seattle.

Section 2. That all lands, rights, privileges and other property lying within the limits of the lots, blocks, or tracts of land described in Section One (1) hereof, be and the same are hereby condemned, appropriated, taken and

damaged for street purposes.

Section 3. That the entire cost of the improvement provided for herein shall be paid by special assessment upon property specially benefited, in the manner provided by law, and that no part thereof shall be paid from the General Fund of the City of Seattle.

Section 4. That the Corporation Counsel be and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the action and proceedings, in the manner provided by law, to condemn, take, damage and appropriate the lands and other property necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance; and also to take the steps necessary to make such special assessment.

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency)

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
