ORDINANCE NO. 32504

AN ORDINANCE vacating portions of Eighth Avenue Northwest and West Forty-first Street on the petition of the Northern Pacific Railway Company.

Whereas, there has been filed with the city council the petition of the Northern Pacific Railway Company for the vacation of portions of Eighth Avenue Northwest and West Forty-first Street, being File No. 54490; and

Whereas, at the time and place of the hearing on said petition the same was duly granted by the city council;

Now Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SEATTLE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described portions of Eighth Avenue Northwest and West Forty-first Street, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of West Forty-first Street and the east line of Eighth Avenue Northwest; thence north along the east line of Eighth Avenue Northwest to a point that is forty (40) feet distant northwesterly from the center line of the Northern Pacific franchise when measured at right angles thereto; thence in a southwesterly direction along a curved line to an intersection with the west line of Eighth Avenue Northwest, said curved line being forty (40) feet northwesterly from and parallel to the center line of the Northern Pacific franchise when measured at right angles thereto; thence south along the west line of said Eighth Avenue Northwest to an intersection with the center line of West Forty-first Street ~~thence east along the center line of West Forty-first Street to the point of beginning~~ ~~thence east along the center line of West Forty-first Street to the point of beginning~~ extended west; thence east along the center line of West Forty-first Street to the point of beginning,

be and the same are hereby vacated.

Ordinance 32504

(To be used for all Ordinances except Emergency.)

Section 2 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from and after its passage and approval, if approved by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect at the time it shall become a law under the provisions of the city charter.
